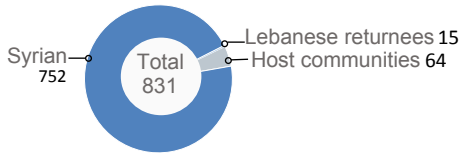

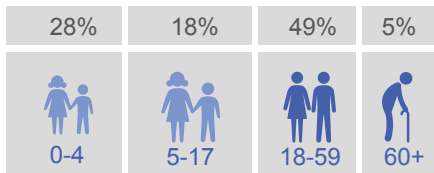

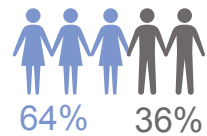


Distribution of consultations

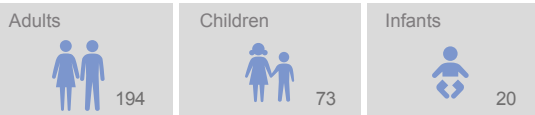

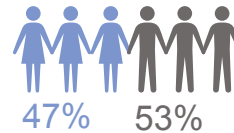

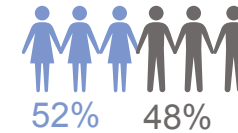


IOM will assist with the temporary resettlement of 3,500 Syrians, in coordination with the German government and UNHCR.

NEW ARRIVALS IMMUNIZATION AND SUPPORT TO NATIONAL IMMUNIZATION CAMPAIGNS

IOM teams are immunizing Syrian Refugees upon arrival in Raba'a Al-Sarhan transit center (RSTC).

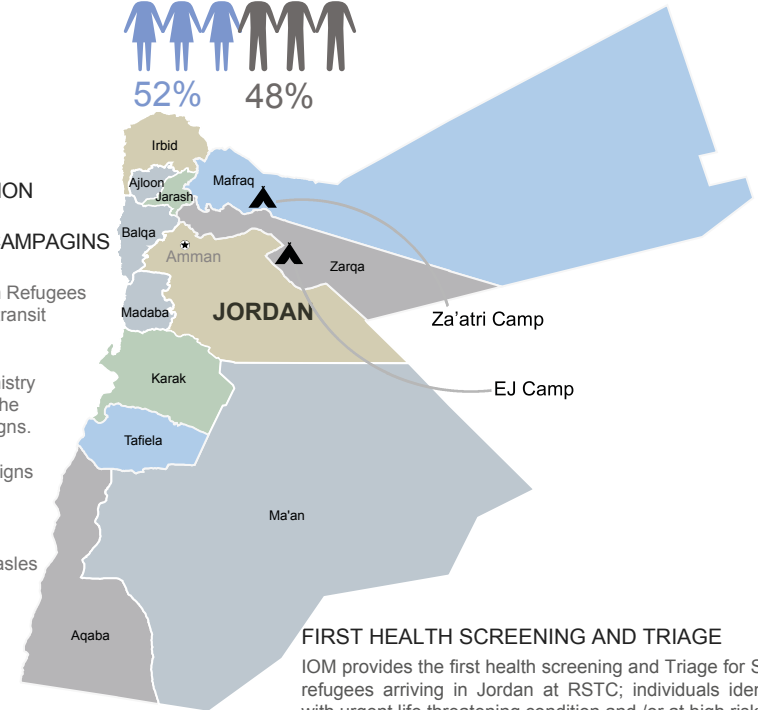
IOM works with the Jordanian Ministry of Health (MoH) and partners on the nation-wide immunization campaigns.

The national immunization campaigns targeted millions of individuals

under 20 years old against measles and German measles (MR)

under 5 years old against polio

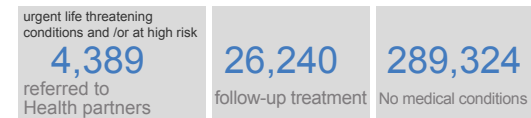
IOM teams are immunizing Syrian refugees in Za'atari Camp and providing transport support to some MoH teams to reach Syrian families in remote locations.



FIRST HEALTH SCREENING AND TRIAGE

IOM provides the first health screening and Triage for Syrian refugees arriving in Jordan at RSTC; individuals identified with urgent life threatening condition and /or at high risk are internally refer to the responsible health partner in the center while individuals identified for follow-up treatment are referred to the responsible health partner inside the camps.
