INSIDE SYRIA ACTIVITIES HIGHLIGHTS

- NFI** Distribution of Non-Food Items (NFIs)
Over 152,000 persons received NFIs across 7 governorates
- Rehabilitation of Collective Shelters**
3 were rehabilitated hosting 2,000 displaced persons
17 under ongoing work out of total planned 50 collective shelters
- Emergency Evacuation of Vulnerable Migrants**
Over 3,400 third country nationals (TCNs) were evacuated
- Psychosocial Support**
42 locally-based care providers trained

IN NEIGHBOURING COUNTRIES ACTIVITIES HIGHLIGHTS

- Jordan**
Over 312,000 syrian refugees assisted with transportation,
Over 410,000 individuals received emergency health assistance
- Lebanon**
Over 86,000 individuals received NFIs and over 15,000 received shelter supports
Over 2,600 refugees received transit assistance
- Turkey**
Over 55,600 individuals received NFIs
- Iraq**
Over 28,500 individuals received NFIs
