SALVADOREAN MIGRATION

Flows Dynamic

- 50's-70's: Professional and ocassional migration.
- 80's: Migration as a result of armed conflict and violence.
- Middle of the 90's: economic migration (postwar conflict), family reunification (documented and undocumented) and natural disasters.



SALVADOREAN MIGRATION

Impacts:

- Increase of family and collective remittances
- Strengthened relationships between salvadorean communities abroad and their communities of origin with multiple and dynamic impacts
 - Changes in sociocultural behavior Formas de participación ciudadana y procesos de toma de decisiones
 - Local investment processes and growth in trade and services
 - Relevance of media
- Strengthened relationships between different communities abroad
 - Growth of networks by areas of interest
 - Joint meetings and projects
- Build-up of a Community (Society) abroad
 - Complex and diverse interests (heterogeneus)
 - Increased levels of organizational structures
 - Increased presence and influence in local politics



CREATION OF THE VICEMINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS FOR THE SALVADOREANS ABROAD

The creation of the Viceministry institutionalize in a visionary manner the permanent link between the salvadoreans abroad and El Salvador within an appropriate institutional framework.



PRACTICAL EXAMPLES OF WORK WITH SALVADOREAN ORGANIZATIONS ABROAD: FUTURE ACTIONS

- MIGRATION FORUM AND PRIVATE SECTOR,
 - The Regional Conference on Migration (RCM) is exploring the correlation of Migration and development.
 - The interest to link the activities of the private sector with the effects of international migration, specially by the growth of emerging sectors that base its entreprenurial performance in their relation with migration.

HOUSING FAIR ABROAD

- Real state as productive investments of family remittances
- It is involved complementary components to mortgage credit with savings and bonds investment
- Existent portfolio to date : \$100 million dollars



LESSONS LEARNED

- Is key to make alliances with the organized civil society and the private sector with the communities abroad, through programs of social responsability, or even, national programs of support to the returning migrant.
- Media plays a fundamental role in the promotion of the work with communities.
- Multilateral organizations can develop an efective agenda of sinergies in the strategic themes from their areas of specialization, considering the migration phenomena.



SUGGESTIONS TO IOM AND OTHER MULTILATERAL ORGANIZATIONS

- Provide technical support to programs of investment of family remittances for productive uses:
 - Benefits of Free Trade Agreements
 - Development of transnational business opportunities
 - Productions of Investments Portfolios
 - Migratory programs associated with temporary labor
 - Demande niche in developed countries
 - Programs of preparadness prior to departure

Programs for the better use and exchange of Talented and skillful people abroad.







SUGGESTIONS TO IOM AND OTHER MULTILATERAL ORGANIZATIONS

- Campaigns of information of risks regarding undocumented migration
- Awareness campaigns to combat traficking
- Contribute to make the processes of deportations, orderly, efficient, secure and with full respect for human rights of migrants.
- Capacity building at all levels: Government, communities, leaders.
- Prospectives on the future of migration, particularly for the existent strong flows
- Studies of the contributions of migrants in their host societies
- Characterization of diasporas to facilitate public policy design and their implementation.
