


Effects of migration on the origin country

- The possible effects on public health are reduced comparatively with those that can be encountered in the destination country.
- However, they are not insignificant and they could consist in:
 - emigration of health workers;
 - the decrease of money collected by the health insurance founds/companies;
 - the import of epidemic diseases, in case of cycle migration.
