The International Organization for Migration (**IOM**) is an intergovernmental humanitarian organization established in 1951 and is committed to the principle that humane and orderly migration benefits both migrants and society.

In the framework of the IOM compound enlargements, the IOM Bids Evaluation and Award Committee ("**BEAC**") now invites interested Contractors to bid for the proposed *Construction works at IOM compound, Kabul, Afghanistan*.

Eligibility for obtaining the complete set of ITB (Instruction to Bidders) is that interested bidders must have sufficient experience in buildings construction works that will be proved by providing the list with completed projects with total value of at least One Million USD (\$ 1,000,000) for the last 3 years, along with a valid business license through email to iomkabulprocurement@iom.int as of **Wednesday 04 April and latest by Thursday 12 April 2018 - 16:00hrs**.

Eligible Contractors will receive a notification to visit IOM office in Kabul for receiving of the complete set of Bidding Document in CD disks.

A pre-bidding meeting and site visit will be held at IOM office located at Street No. 4, House No. 27 Ansari Square, Shahr-i-Naw, Kabul, Afghanistan on **Sunday 15 April 2018 at 14:00hrs**, where all details of the project will be discussed.

Bids shall be valid for a period of *90 days* after submission of Bids and must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 2.5% of the total Bid and shall be delivered to the BEAC at *House No 27, Street No 4, Ansari watt, Shar e Now, Kabul, Afghanistan* on or before **Thursday 19 April 2018, at 14:00 hours**. Late submission of bids will not be accepted.

Bids will be opened at the above address on **22 April 2018 at 10:00 hours**. *Bidders who will submit bids can attend bid opening meeting.*

IOM reserves the right to accept or reject any bids, and to cancel the procurement process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without obligation to inform the affected Bidder/s of the ground for IOM action.
