PROPOSAL BULLETIN NO. 3009-01

Modernization of information-telecommunication system (ITS) GART-5 for the State Border Guard Service of Ukraine in scopes of the Project “Support for Migration and Asylum Management in Ukraine”

08 June 2018

The Bids Evaluation and Awards Committee of IOM Ukraine hereby issues Bid Bulletin No. 3009-01 to answer the following requests for clarifications:

- 1. Please clarify what guarantee shall accompany Proponent’s proposal as there are three different forms in Section VI of Instruction to Proponents? What amount shall be covered by guarantee?**

IOM’s Official Answer:

Pursuant to Invitation to Submit Proposals, the Proponent shall furnish, as part of its proposal, a bid security guarantee in the form of bank guarantee from a reputable commercial banking institution amounting to 2% of total bid. Format of the bid security provided in Section VI (B). Bid security shall be valid for at least sixty (60) calendar days from the date of the scheduled opening of the bids.

The bid security is required to protect IOM against the risk of Proponent’s conduct, which would warrant the security’s forfeiture.

The bid security shall be denominated in Euro or in Ukrainian Hryvnia (UAH) in form of bank guarantee callable on demand and acquired from a bank acceptable to IOM. The bid security denominated in UAH should be equivalent of 2% of total bid in Euro using the UN Operational Exchange Rates on the month the bank guarantee is acquired.

Any bid not secured in accordance with this Instruction will be considered by IOM as non-responsive.

Unsuccessful Proponents’ bid securities will be discharged or returned as promptly as possible but not later than thirty (30) days after the expiration of the period of bid validity prescribed by IOM.

The winning Proponent’s bid security will be discharged after the Proponent signs the contract, and furnishing the advance / performance security, pursuant to format in Section VI (A, C).

Necessary amendment was introduced to Instruction to Proponent in order to stipulate this requirement in more details (refer to cl. 8.9 – 8.10 of ITP).

- 2. What document shall be submitted by Proponent to prove payment of taxes for the last business year?**

IOM’s Official Answer:

Tax declaration for the last business year and certificate on absence of debt for tax payments issued by state tax authority can serve as confirmation of tax payment by Proponent.

The Bids Evaluation and Awards Committee of IOM Ukraine through this Proposal Bulletin informs all Proponents for the aforementioned tender that amendment to Instruction to Proponents were introduced, describing requirements regarding bid security. Updated Bidding Document is already posted on IOM web-site.

Proponents should use the Revised Bidding Document in preparing their bids.
