Lot 1.1. / Lot 1.2. Item#1 What exactly is the requested weight for the tarpaulin? It is requested to be 4*5m in size, and the weight per m2 is 200gr, which makes it 4kg, but the total weight requested is stated as 4.800gr. Please clarify the min. required weight?	Kindly note that the correct min weigh is - 200g/m² ±5%, total: 4000g ±5%
Lot 1.1. / Lot 1.2. Item#1 please specify the color of tarpaulin, shall it be white or gray and black? Any reference image can help.	Material is white. Reinforcement bands black. Please see reference picture (1)
Lot 1.2. item#2. What is the exact measurement for the Plastic Sheet? It needs to be 3m*10m for a total of 30 m2. Please confirm the size?	The measurement of the plastic sheet is 3m*10m for a total of 30 m2
How to request Product Packaging. Sack, parcel, etc.	The small items (not including plywood, batten, lath) to be packaged in durable bag with IOM logo and items contents similar or better. Please see reference picture (2)
Item 2.5. What do you mean by "IOM Logo printed on one side. 3 logos (25 x 50cm) evenly spaced."? We may provide a sticker on the top of bulk package, will it be sufficient?	IOM sticker is not permitted on plywood or roofing sheet. Logo to be painted or spray painted using appropriate paint or spray paint.
Transparent plastic sheet; this item is usually requested in 30m ² single piece, however on the technical specification it is requested 3 metres x 300mm and 30m ² , please confirm which diameter is correct. 3m*10m for a total of 30 m2	The measurement of the plastic sheet is 3m*10m for a total of 30 m2
Both nails are quoted in minus double digits. Usually 6mm nails are requested 1kg in a box and 2mm is 500gr. The weights given are 10 times less than the current weight.	The weights are correct 0.05kg and 0.1kg per kit. They should be packed in a bag or box as described
Both ESK kits (A and B) are apart from rope, claw hammer and utility knife, please confirm that the RFQ has the exact value without them.	This question is unclear.
Is it possible for the Battens product to have dimensions 25x100x4000 instead of 25x100x4500?	Minimum length is 4m. 4.5m is acceptable.
For the Lath, you have specified the quantity per package as 10 pieces. Is it possible to pack 100 pieces per pack?	Laths, plywood, batten do not need to be packaged as per kit contents. They can be packaged palletized in bulk delivery.
