Purpose of the Invitation	IOM seeks to form partnerships with legal entities including private sector	
Purpose of the invitation	companies or social enterprises, with the aim of developing sanitation solutions for people with specific needs in Ethiopia i.e., people suffering from incontinence and children aged below 3 years who are not able to use toilets independently. The solutions being sought should contribute to reduction of health and environmental risks associated with open defecation and challenging disposal of used materials for managing incontinence and young children's faeces. The solutions can either be products or services.	
	IOM is seeking one or more private sector companies (national or international) to partner with in delivering one or more of the following three key functions of the Sanitation for All project:	
	 Design innovative solution(s) that are affordable, acceptable to users and are environment friendly to help people suffering from light, moderate and heavy incontinence (Urinary and Faecal) to better manage their condition. 	
	 Design innovative solution(s) that are affordable, acceptable to users and are environment friendly to help mothers and caregivers of children aged below 3 years who are unable to independently use toilets to better manage their children's faeces. 	
	 Capacity building of five local groups to produce the sanitary solutions for either function 1 or 2 or both (depending on the entity's area of interest). 	
	Interested entities <u>do not</u> need to be experts or have experience in all the three areas highlighted, rather, they may choose an area that they feel confident they can deliver based on their experience. Therefore, interested entities can bid for either function 1 or 2 or all the three functions.	
	Upon selection, partners will be expected to contribute to the development and pilot the innovative solutions.	
	It is expected that entities delivering either function 1 or 2, will also collaborate with IOM and its partners involved in the project to support the empowerment of local groups through capacity building to produce selected solutions/products that the entity will have helped to design.	
	IOM envisages that at least 5 local groups will be capacity built. These groups will be identified by a partner to be engaged separately by IOM. The Private Sector entity's role in the capacity building will be to coordinate with IOM and the partner to train the groups to produce the designed solutions locally.
