B&H floods

Affected: 1 mil people directly and indirectly

Humanitarian Phase **Successful**

Casualties: 25 (NO REPORTED CHANGE)

Evacuated people: est. 20,000 remaining

Landslides: 3000+ reported

Posavina region remains severely affected



The most pressing concerns are: landslides, animal carcasses and debris, damages to agriculture and livestock; paralysis of the industrial sector; temporary loss of jobs; damages to administration services

2,600 people in collective centers

There are 14 collective centers in FBiH, 10 in RS and 2 in District Brčko;


