Management Response and Actions IOM Country Office Kuala Lumpur Audit File No. MY201801

The IOM Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducted an internal audit of the IOM Kuala Lumpur (the “Country Office”) from 16 to 20 April 2018. The audit assessed the risk exposure and risk management of the Country Office’s activities, in order to ensure these are well understood and controlled by the country-level management and staff. The audit covered the activities of the Country Office from February 2016 to March. The results of the audit are public and can be accessed through IOM’s global website¹.

The OIG assessed the Office as substantially effective, and raised 14 audit findings and recommendations, out of which 1 is high priority. As of June 2020, only 1 recommendation remains open, which requires coordination with headquarters units in relation to the legal status of the Country Office and was thus marked as ‘for the record’.
