Supply and Delivery of Armored Vehicles to IOM Somalia

BID BULLETIN
Addendum No. 1

This Addendum No. 01 is issued to modify information provided in the Request for Quotation and General Instructions to Suppliers for the *Supply and Delivery of Armored Vehicles to IOM Somalia* issued to the prospective Suppliers on *04 April 2019*.

A. General Instructions to Bidders

1. Scope of Bid

Clause 1.1 of the Bidding Documents should read as:

*"1.1 IOM invites bids for the supply and delivery of Toyota Land Cruiser 76 fully Certified Armoring Level at VR7 with Ballistic Level **B7** to IOM Somalia under DAP IOM Somalia Incoterms as per below delivery address hereto referred as Goods. The Goods is specified in greater details in the Sub Section of the Bid Documents.*

Clause 1.2 of the Bidding Documents should read as:

"1.2 The successful Bidder is expected to complete the armored vehicle by the Intended Completion Date which is 30-45 calendar days after signature of Contract. This excludes the transit and customs clearance processing time."

2. Submission of Bids

Clause 19.2(b) of the Bidding Documents should read as follows:

*"(b) bear the Project name, the Invitation for Bids (IFB) title and reference number, and a statement: "DO NOT OPEN BEFORE **17 May 2019**, 1500H Manila Time".*

3. Deadline for Submission of Bids

Clause 20.1 of Bidding Documents should read as follows:

*"20.1 Bids must be received by IOM at the address specified under ITB Clause 19.2.a no later than **17 May 2019**, 1500H Manila Time."*

4. Opening of Bids

Manila Administrative Centre

*“23.1 IOM will open all bids in the presence of bidders’ representatives who choose to attend, at the time, on the date, and at the place specified herein **17 May 2019**, 1600H Manila Time. The bidders’ representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance.”*

B.1. Response to Bidders’ Inquiries/Clarification – Commercial Concerns

Q1: Is it possible to receive the 100% through an irrevocable and confirmed Letter of Credit? If not applicable, what is the maximum amount which can be paid in advance for which we can submit an Advance Payment Guarantee (as per Form 6 at page 46 of the Bid Document)?

A: All advanced payment terms are NOT permitted. In the event an advanced payment cannot be avoided, IOM may consider exceptionally agreeing to lowest possible advance payment of up to USD 10,000.

Q2: Is the Bid Security of 2% of the initial cost required for this Tender? If the Bid Security is required, will IOM accept a soft copy of the Bid Security since we intend to do an online submission to the email provided in the ITB document or do we submit a hard copy of the Bid security to Philippines? – We can also submit a hardcopy to IOM Offices in Mogadishu on or before 24th April 2019 if that’s an option.

A: No. Bid security is not applicable for this ITB. Please refer to Clause 17 of the bidding documents.

Q3: Could you please confirm at which time (preferably which month) the contract will be awarded to the successful bidder?

A: Notice of Award/Contract will be issued between the last week of May and first week of June 2019.

Q4: Could you please provide us with the complete address of IOM Somalia office since we are supposed to quote on a DAP-basis?

A: Below is the complete address of IOM Somalia

Q6: Applicable taxes for IOM in Somalia: Please clarify if IOM will pick up the cars from MOGADISHU PORT and do the customs clearance of vehicles since they are operating in Somalia?

A: Incoterm is Delivered At Place (DAP), which means that vendor will deliver the vehicles from place of origin to Mogadishu Port. IOM Somalia will process the customs clearance and apply tax exemption documents. Once cleared from customs, vendor will transfer the vehicles from Mogadishu Port to IOM Somalia office.

Q7: The armored vehicles are for whom? (ex. VIP, Politician, Businessman)?

A: Vehicles are for the sole use of the Organization/IOM Staff.

Q8: A concern about the delivery time of the fleet, as the vehicles you requested are scarce and must be sourced from distant locations, requiring 40 days to arrive to our plant. Then, we will need a minimum time of 30 days to build the fleet.

A: AV is required to be produced from 30 days to 45 days. This excludes the shipment schedule from origin to IOM Somalia as this will be dependent on availability of export approval and vessel availability.

B.2. Response to Bidders' Inquiries/Clarification – Technical Concerns

Q1: Will IOM accept another brand of armored vehicle (from another Nigeria manufacturer where armored vehicles are currently being used by the Nigerian Military in fighting insurgency at the Northern Nigeria) that can match same standard with that of the Toyota brand you are requesting for?

A: No, we are not accepting other brands since all local service stations in Somalia are mostly Toyota specialist.

Q2: Can we please know if the VR7 certificate is mandatory or B6 CEN 1522/23 is acceptable?

A: VPAM VR7 certification is required for the armoured vehicles.

Q3: Please provide as much as possible further details regarding the optional equipment?

A: As for the optional equipment – microphone, this is an external listening device. Microphone are used to communicate with people outside the vehicle since vehicle windows cannot be lowered because it's armoured. The device helps with external communication without opening the vehicle doors and exposing passengers to any risks.

Q4: Is there any specific documentation needed to be provided from our side, in order for the IOM to clear and register the cars within Somalia? Example: export/import license or any other relevant documents that required for the clearance of this cars in Somalia?

A: Aside from export clearance documents, awarded vendor must provide all original shipping documents such as: Certificate of Origin (COO), waybill, shipping invoice and packing list.

Q5: What Year Model is Required

A: The preferred year model is 2019. If not applicable, year model 2018.

Q6: Are the required TLC 76/78 RHD or LHD?

A: The required TLC 76/78 is Left Hand Drive (LHD)

Q7: We understand that the requirement is for Landcruiser 76, armored level B6. The Invitation for Bids mentions VR7 and B6 also which is wrong as it cannot be together. Kindly clarify if it is B6 armored? Or, can we propose for B6 Armored

A: The requirement is VR7 and B7.

Q8: What is the brand of the vehicle with the model name and number (for ex. GXR, VXR)?

A: The vehicle brand and model is TLC 76

Q9: What is the number of units required?

A: The number of units required is four (4) units

Q11: What is the preferred engine?

A: The required engine is V8.

Q13: What is the preferred fuel? Diesel or Petrol?

A: The preferred fuel is Diesel.

Q14: What level of Armoring is needed?

A: The level or armoring needed is B7.
