83% of migrants said they had some level of education, 17% said no education

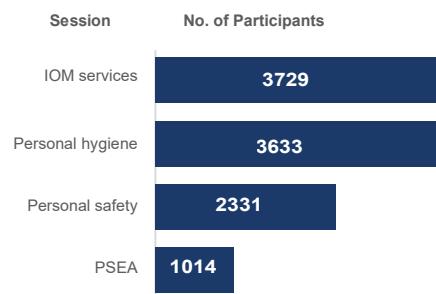


82% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

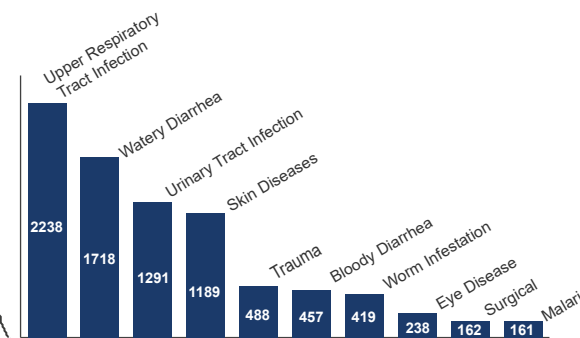

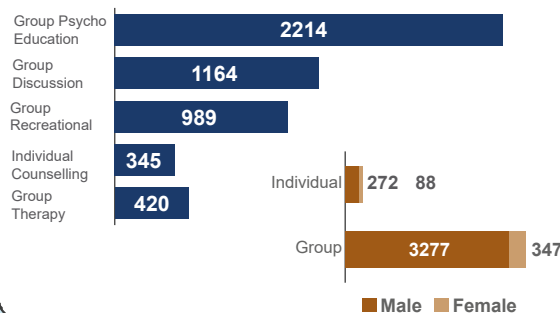

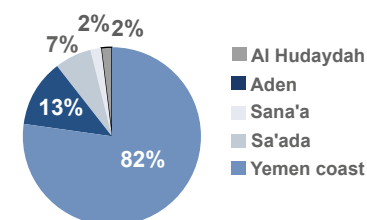
Health: Most Common Diagnosis
