76% of migrants said they had some level of education, 24% said no education

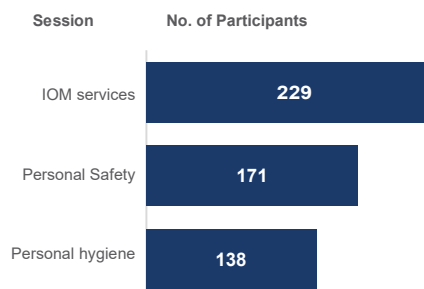


79% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

Other Factors Contributing to a Migrant's Vulnerability Level

- 13 unaccompanied minors
- 27 migrants verbally abused
- 32 migrants psychologically abused
- 23 migrants deceived
- 34 migrants robbed
- 38 migrants threatened

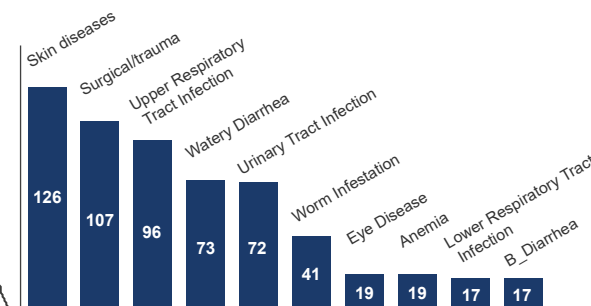

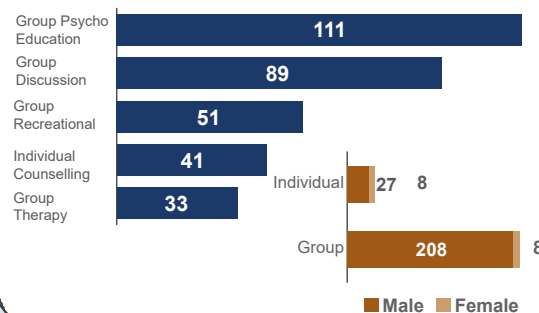

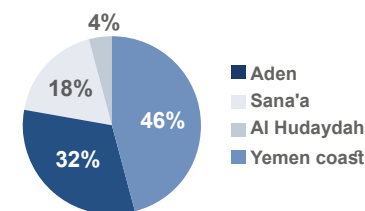
Health: Most Common Diagnosis
