Human Rights Violations Suffered During Migration in Yemen



73 victims of abduction



90 victims of extortion



69 victims of torture



\$477 was the average amount paid by migrants to smugglers



87% of migrants said they had some level of education, 13% said no education



87% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

Other Factors Contributing to a Migrant's Vulnerability Level

- 28 unaccompanied minors
- 77 migrants verbally abused
- 67 migrants psychologically abused
- 96 migrants deceived
- 93 migrants robbed
- 99 migrants threatened

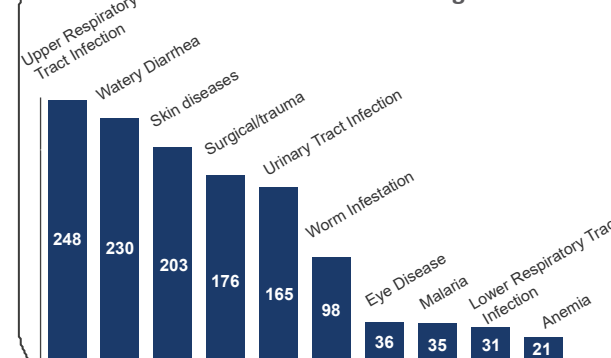

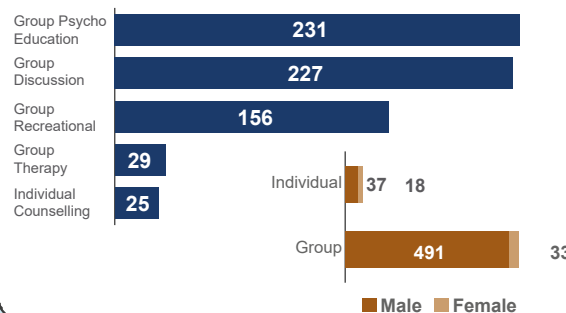

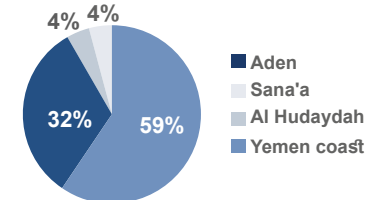
Health: Most Common Diagnosis
