67% of migrants said they had some level of education, 33% said no education

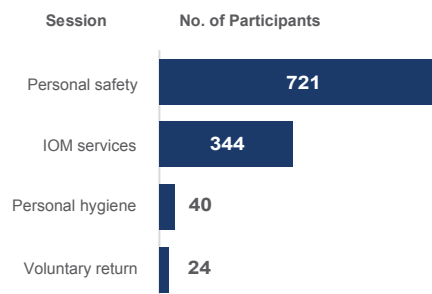


56% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

Other Factors Contributing to a Migrant's Vulnerability Level

- 13 unaccompanied minors
- 27 migrants verbally abused
- 35 migrants psychologically abused
- 34 migrants deceived
- 39 migrants robbed
- 47 migrants threatened

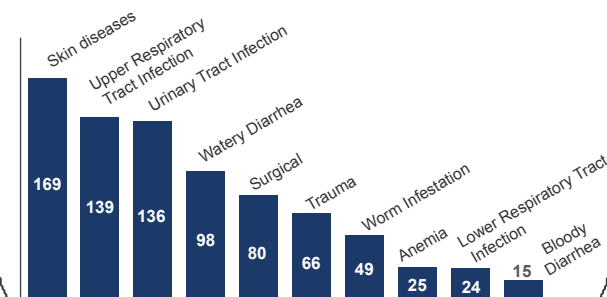

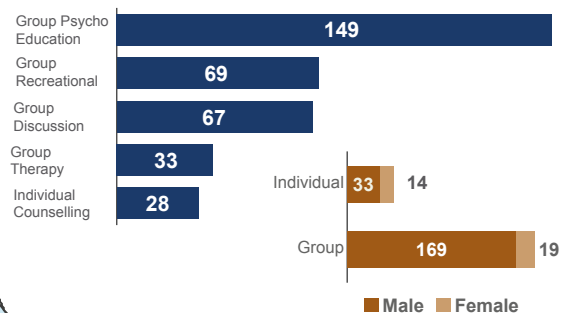

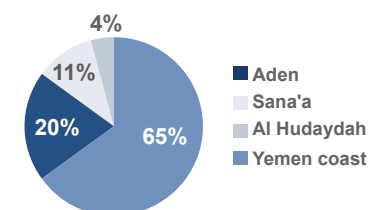
Health: Most Common Diagnosis
