Human Rights Violations Suffered During Migration in Yemen



43 victims of abduction



31 victims of extortion



35 victims of torture



437\$ was the average amount paid by migrants to smugglers



80% of migrants said they had some level of education, 20% said no education



87% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

### Other Factors Contributing to a Migrant's Vulnerability Level

- 8 unaccompanied minors
- 27 migrants verbally abused
- 35 migrants psychologically abused
- 34 migrants deceived
- 39 migrants robbed
- 47 migrants threatened

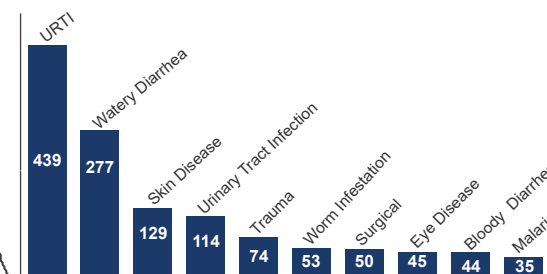


5 Fixed clinics for Migrants

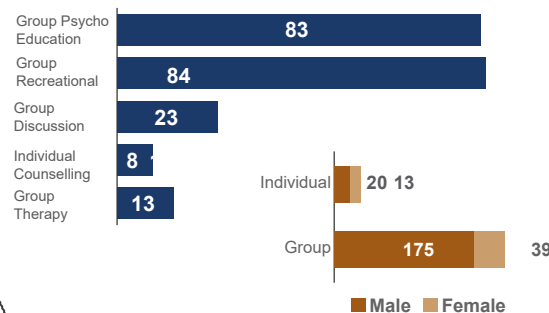

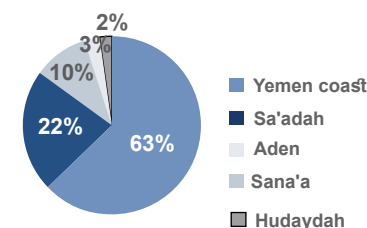
### Health: Most Common Diagnosis
