Human Rights Violations Suffered During Migration in Yemen



24 victims of abduction



37 victims of extortion



21 victims of torture



371\$ was the average amount paid by migrants to smugglers



83% of migrants said they had some level of education, 17% said no education



90% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

### Other Factors Contributing to a Migrant's Vulnerability Level

- 15 unaccompanied minors
- 51 migrants verbally abused
- 20 migrants psychologically abused
- 30 migrants deceived
- 60 migrants robbed
- 60 migrants threatened

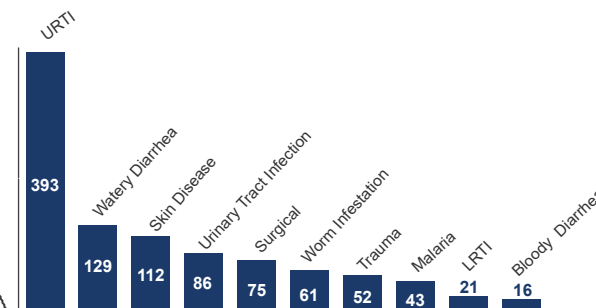


5 Fixed clinics for Migrants

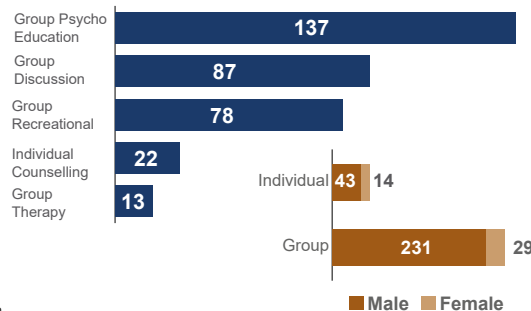

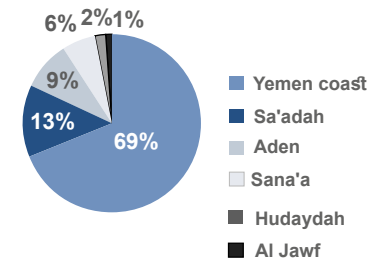
### Health: Most Common Diagnosis
