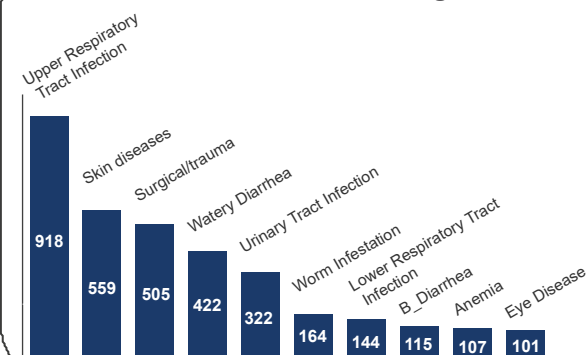

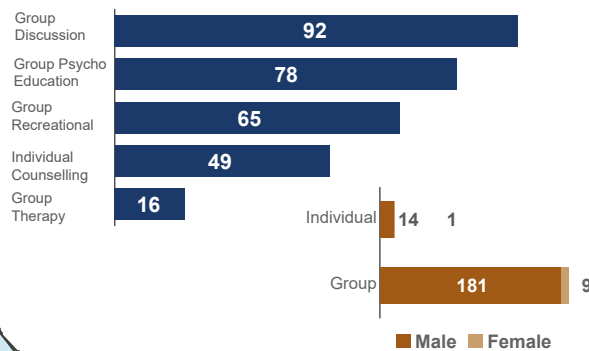

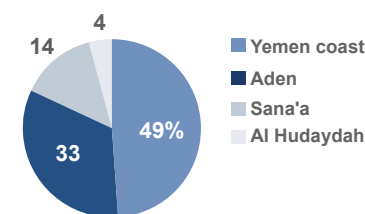
Health: Most Common Diagnosis



Mental Health and Psychosocial Services: Beneficiaries by type of intervention



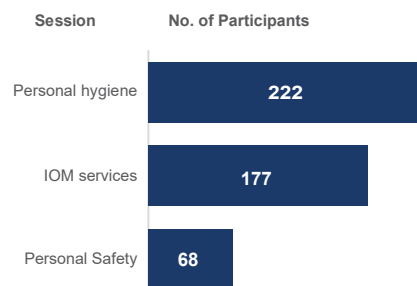
Clinic Beneficiaries per Location
