Human Rights Violations Suffered During Migration in Yemen



28 victims of abduction



46 victims of extortion



21 victims of torture



\$426 was the average amount paid by migrants to smugglers



80% of migrants said they had some level of education, 20% said no education



93% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

### Other Factors Contributing to a Migrant's Vulnerability Level

- 13 unaccompanied minors
- 46 migrants verbally abused
- 22 migrants psychologically abused
- 29 migrants deceived
- 50 migrants robbed
- 50 migrants threatened

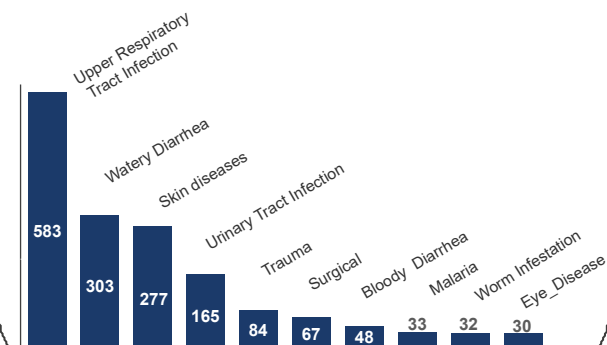


5 Fixed clinics for Migrants

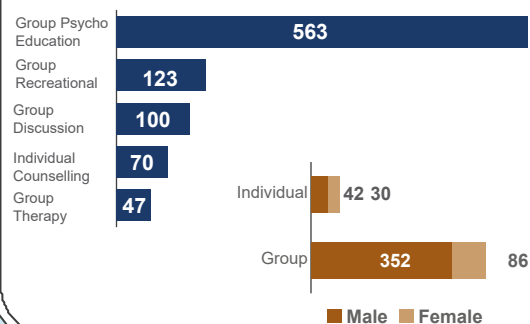

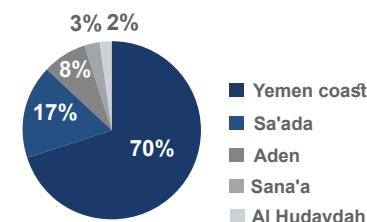
### Health: Most Common Diagnosis
