95% of migrants said they had some level of education, 5% said no education

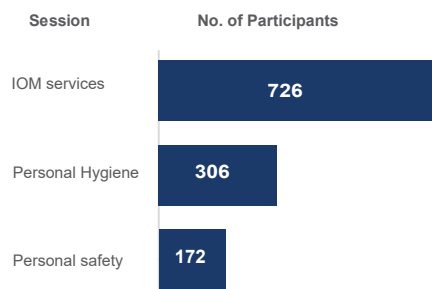


45% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

- 189 migrants psychologically abused
- 111 migrants deceived
- 118 migrants robbed

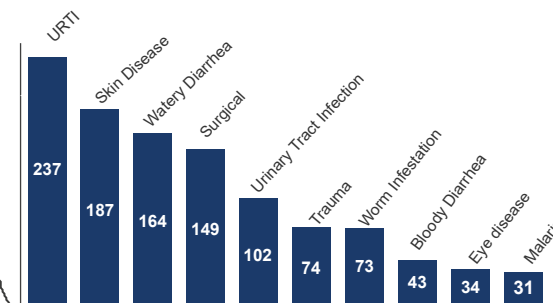


7 Fixed clinics for Migrants

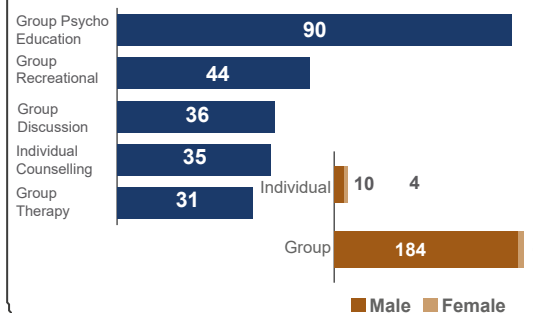

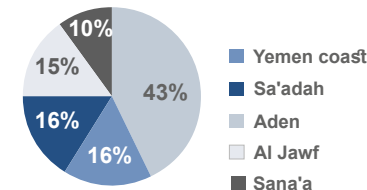
### Health: Most Common Diagnosis
