94% of migrants said they had some level of education, 6% said no education

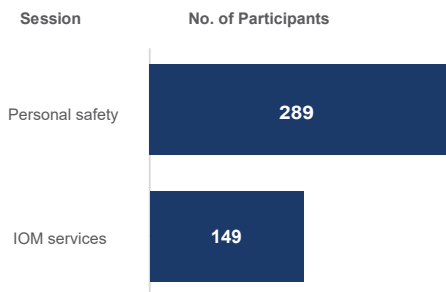


67% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

### Other Factors Contributing to a Migrant's Vulnerability Level

- 24 unaccompanied minors
- 6 migrants verbally abused
- 16 migrants psychologically abused
- 18 migrants deceived
- 18 migrants robbed
- 12 migrants threatened

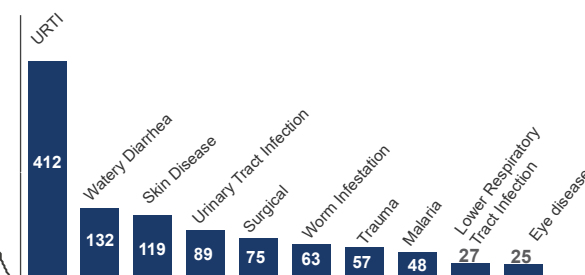

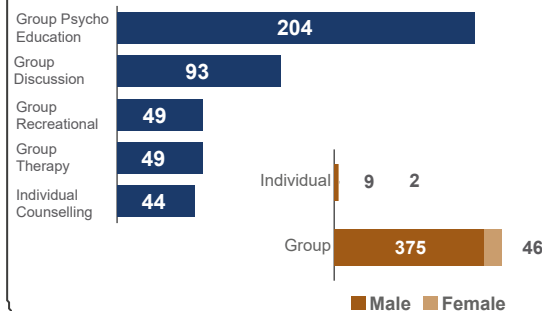

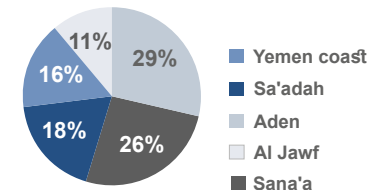
### Health: Most Common Diagnosis
