89% of migrants said they had some level of education, 11% said no education

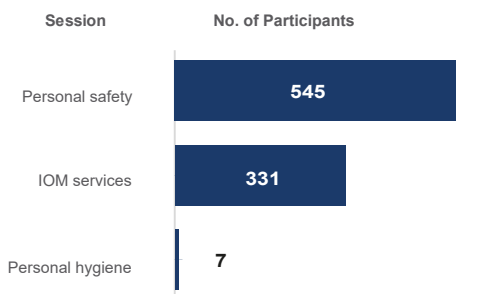


89% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

- 15 migrants verbally abused
- 7 migrants psychologically abused
- 20 migrants deceived
- 19 migrants robbed

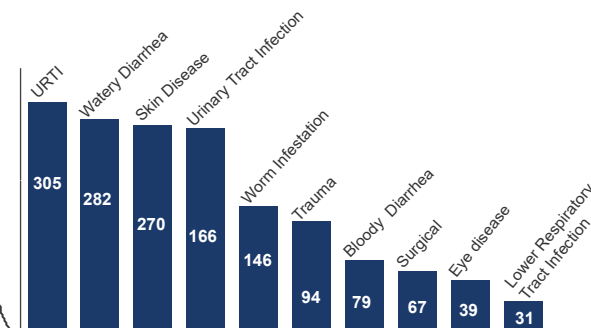

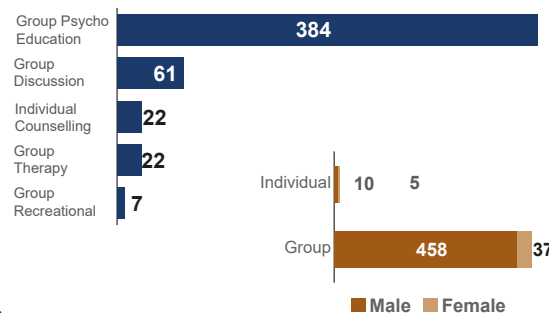

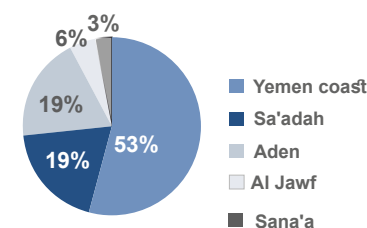
Health: Most Common Diagnosis
