83% of migrants said they had some level of education, 17% said no education

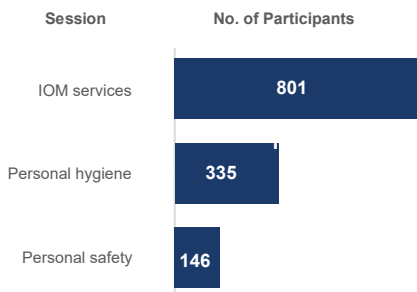


87% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

- 13 unaccompanied minors
- 17 migrants verbally abused
- 13 migrants psychologically abused
- 25 migrants deceived
- 27 migrants robbed
- 29 migrants threatened

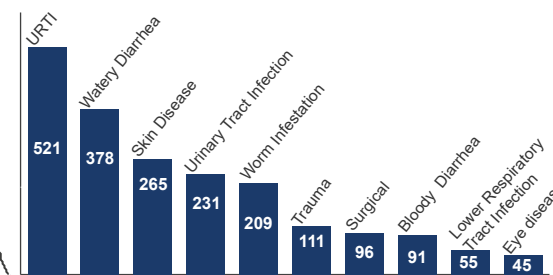

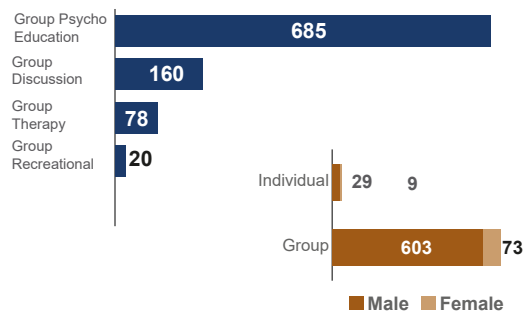

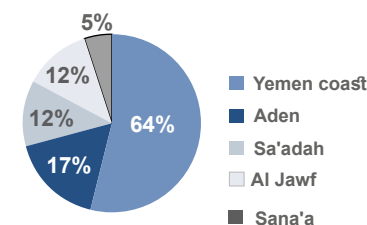
### Health: Most Common Diagnosis
