In the framework of “**Special Measure on supporting the Republic of North Macedonia to improve its border and migration management capabilities**” funded by the **European Union**, the IOM Bids Evaluation and Awards Committee (“**BEAC**”) now invites interested Bidders to submit “**Bid**” for the supply and delivery of *Mobile Surveillance System (MSS) with camera and radar (one vehicle) as per the requested specification.*

Bids shall be valid for a period of **ninety calendar days (90cd)** after the deadline for submission of Bids and must be accompanied by a Bid Security equivalent to not less than **2% (two percent)** of the Bidders Total Bid Price in the form of *bank guarantee or letter of credit from a reputable commercial banking institution* and shall be delivered to the BEAC at **Oslo 6, 1000 Skopje** by **18 August 2020 until 15:00 hours local time**.

Late bids shall be rejected. Bids will be opened at the above address on **18 August 2020 at 16:00 hours local time** in the presence of the Bidders who wish to attend.

IOM reserves the right to accept or reject any bids, and to cancel the procurement process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without obligation to inform the affected Bidder/s of the ground for IOM action.
