ACTION LINES

ATTENTION TO EARLY AND LATE CHILDHOOD AND YOUTH

To attain integral attention for early and late childhood and youth regarding the promotion of fundamental rights such as attention, recreation, education. In such a manner, from a global project, to contribute to the formation during childhood and youth with principles and values that allow them to emerge as subjects.



PROGRAMS AND PROJECTOS FOR WOMEN IN SITUATION OF PROSTITUTION

The corresponding psycho-social accompaniment links the persons with the social and work environments, relating the every-day life with their histories of life and the labor projection in accordance with several training processes

INCOME GENERATION PROCESSES

Programs directed towards training in various occupations to grant different alternatives to working subjects so they may emerge both personally as in the work environment

INTEGRAL ATTENTION FOR THE FAMILY



This line is the basis of providing prevention and attention to inter-family violence, establishing programs to attain a continuous dialogue with the families, reaching continuous agreements, decreasing dysfunctional families generating social capacities to facilitate processes of living together

RESEARCH AND SURVEILLANCE OF SOCIAL AND ENTREPRENEURIAL PROJECTS

Continuous questioning of social conditions allows us to open ways for continuous research with a social and holistic approach to improve the subjects' conditions of the.



GENDER AND EMPOWERMENT PROJECTS

Programs focused on women and the promotion of their rights, as an alternative of acknowledgement and valuation as subjects with social rights



ACTION LINES

PEACEFUL CONFLICT RESOLUTION PROJECTS, HUMAN RIGHTS AND INTER-FAMILY ILL-TREATMENT

This line focuses in the acknowledgment of human rights as a basis to manage peaceful conflict resolution projects and inter-family ill-treatment where the person begins to be acknowledged in its human condition with a guarantee for a dignified life.



INTEGRAL ATTENTION PROGRAMS FOR SENIOR CITIZENS

Integral attention for the senior citizen through ludic programs, health attention programs, disease prevention programs among others, reflecting the conditions of a dignified old age



INTEGRAL ATTENTION FOR DISPLACED PERSONS

Attention for persons in the condition of displacement based on programs that allow their projection in different fields and through strategies such as resilience, to provide them an integral support.



SOME EXCERPTS ABOUT OUR EXPERIENCE



INSTITUTO COLOMBIANO DE BIENESTAR FAMILIAR (COLOMBIAN INSTITUTE OF FAMILY WELFARE): Providing integral attention to 182 children between 6 months to 6 years, with high economic, social, cultural, nutritional, and socio-affective vulnerability through the shelters of the Colombian Institute of Family Welfare and to 24 nursing and pregnant mothers, emphasizing processes of inclusion, education and care as a projection to rescue boys and girls rights.

SECRETARIA DE INTEGRACION SOCIAL (SOCIAL INTEGRATION SECRETARIAT): Providing technical training with employment and entrepreneurial projection in the areas of computing, leather goods, beauty and machine operation to 150 men and women exercising prostitution; this process included the corresponding psycho-social accompaniment which linked people to social and employment aspects, relating every day life with the life histories and their employment projection in accordance with the training program.

LOCAL MAYOR'S OFFICE OF MARTIRES: To develop a recreational-sporting strategy directed towards sexual workers of Los Martires locality as an alternative to promote entertainment and the right of recreation.

UEL-DAAC No. 18-016-00-2001: Execution of technical training workshops in Bakery and Marquetry to 52 handicapped people of the Rafael Uribe Uribe locality through occupational workshops with duration of 240 hours of technical training and 40 hours of administrative training and human formation, wherein the people demonstrated their skills trying to build a social inclusion process with this group of people.

DABS LP- 25 2006: Contracting the service of a program oriented towards training in beauty, with an employment and entrepreneurial projection, under parameters of quality, performance and sense of responsibility directed towards men and women users of project 7310 Attention to people linked to prostitution.

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
