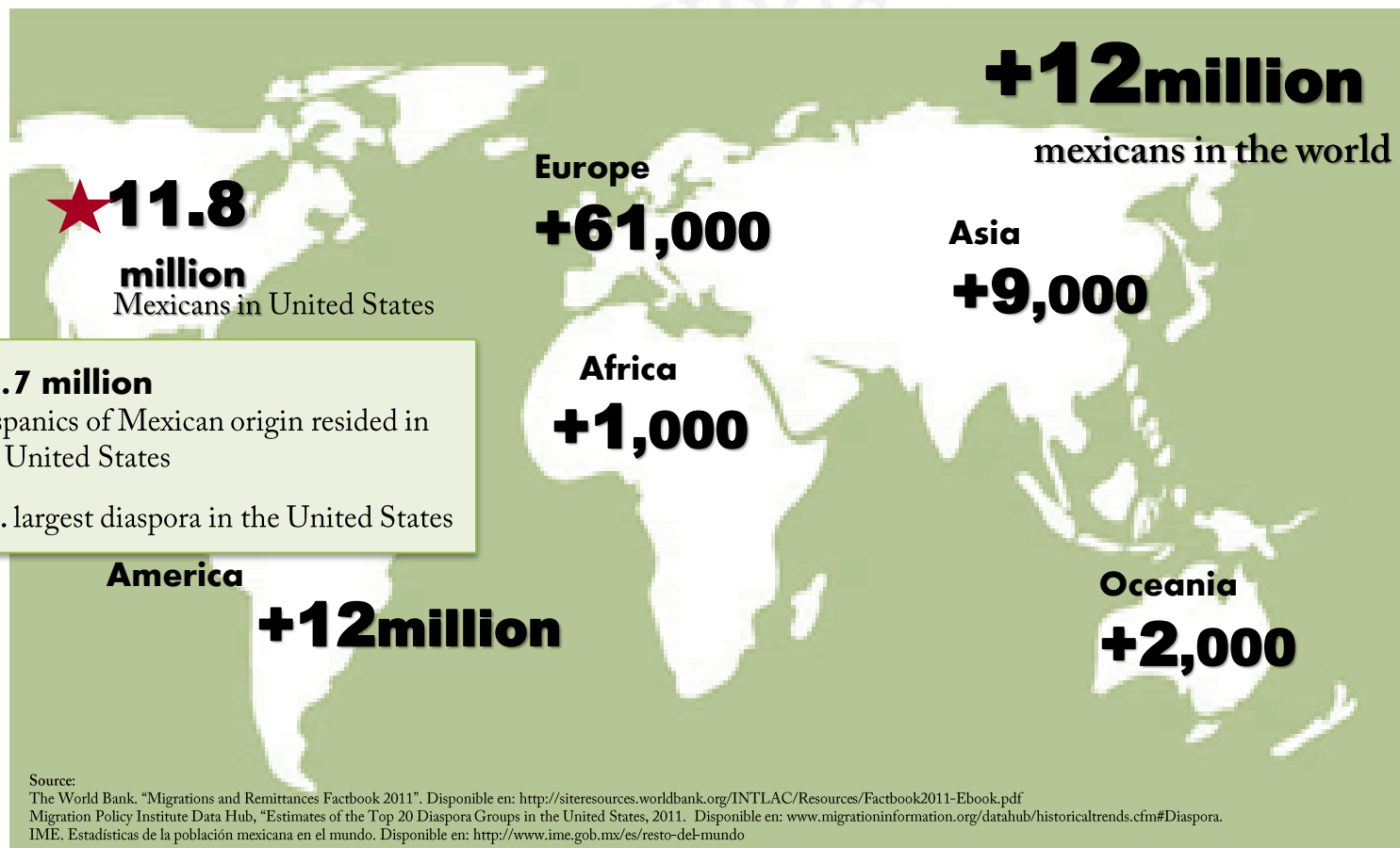

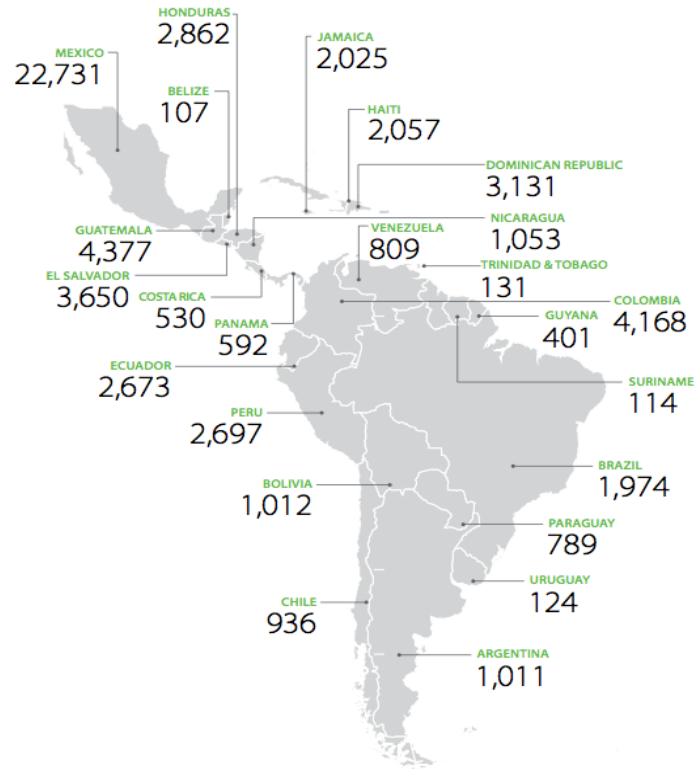

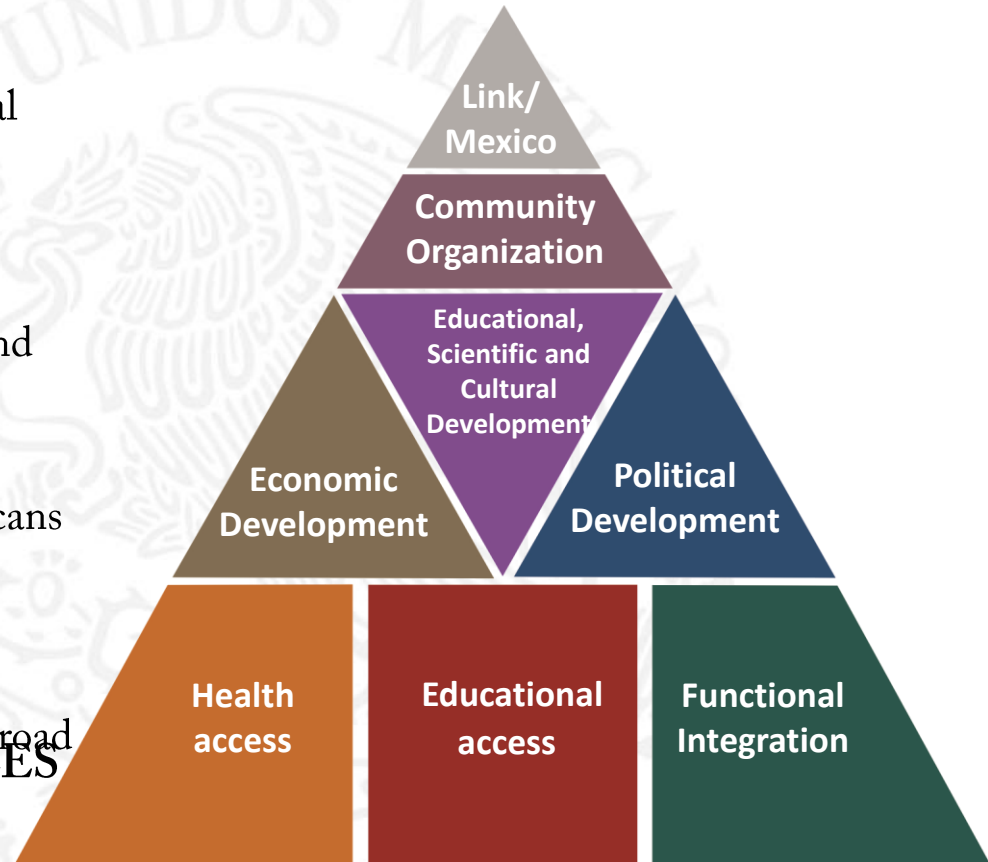
Level 4 – Building binational citizenship.

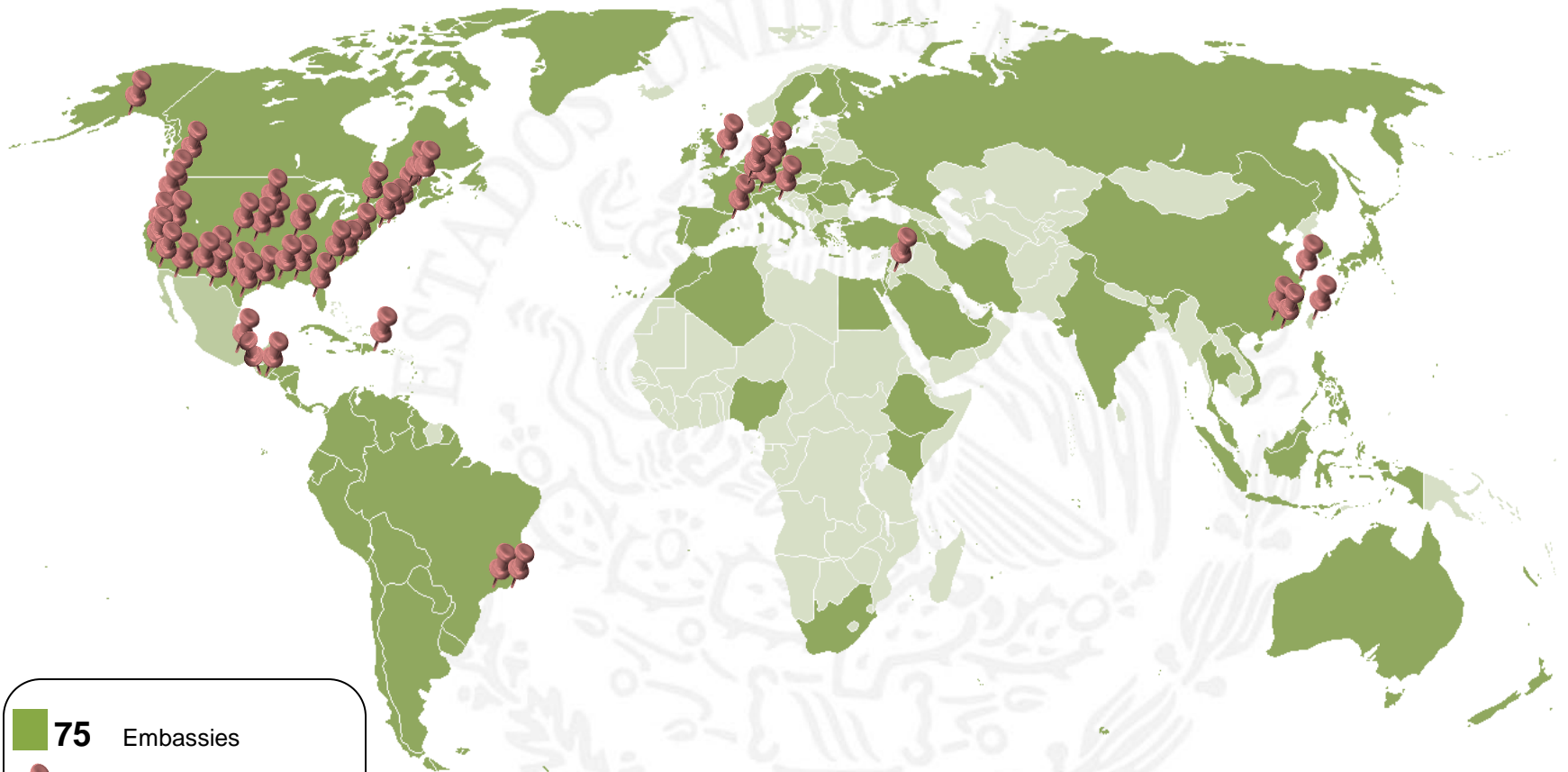
