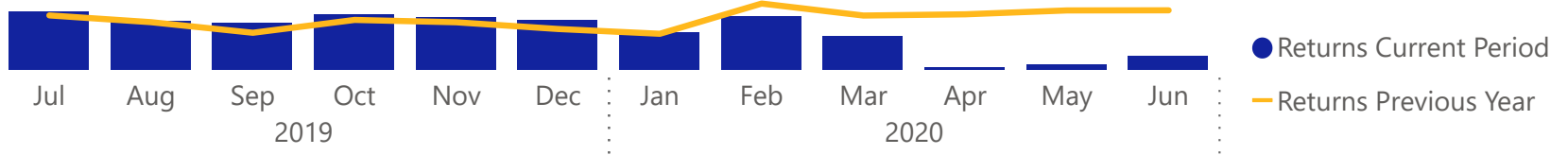

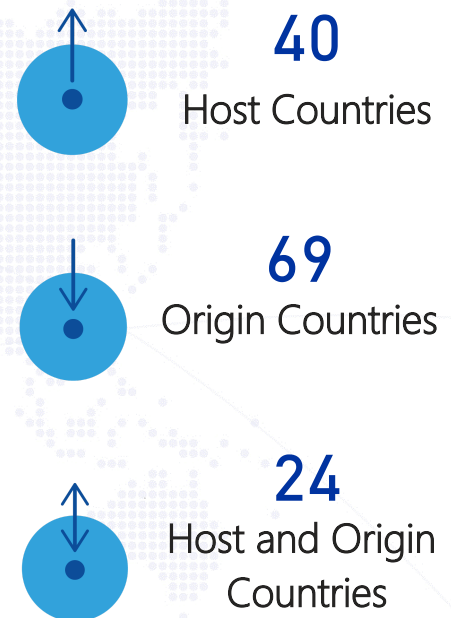

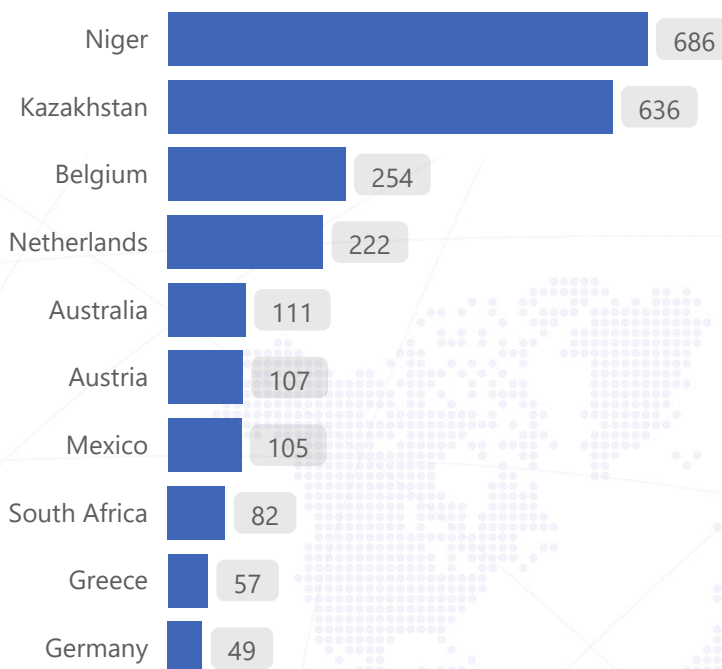

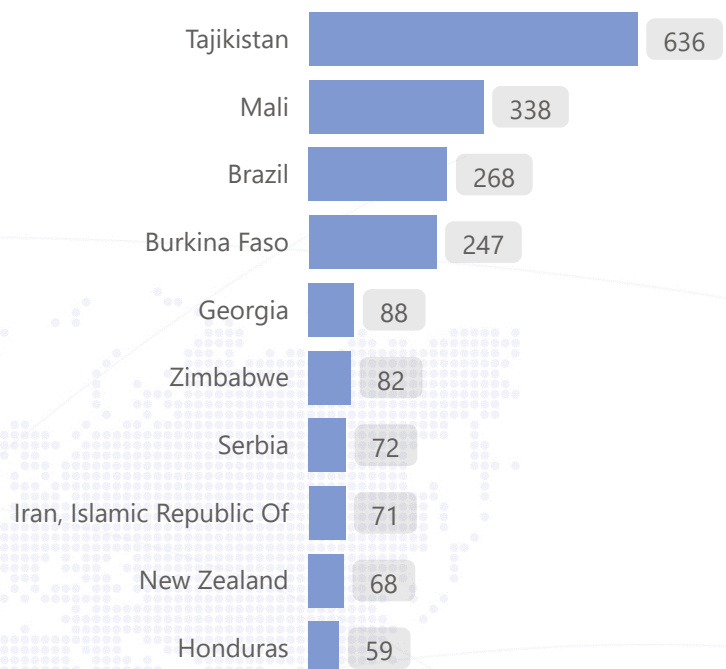

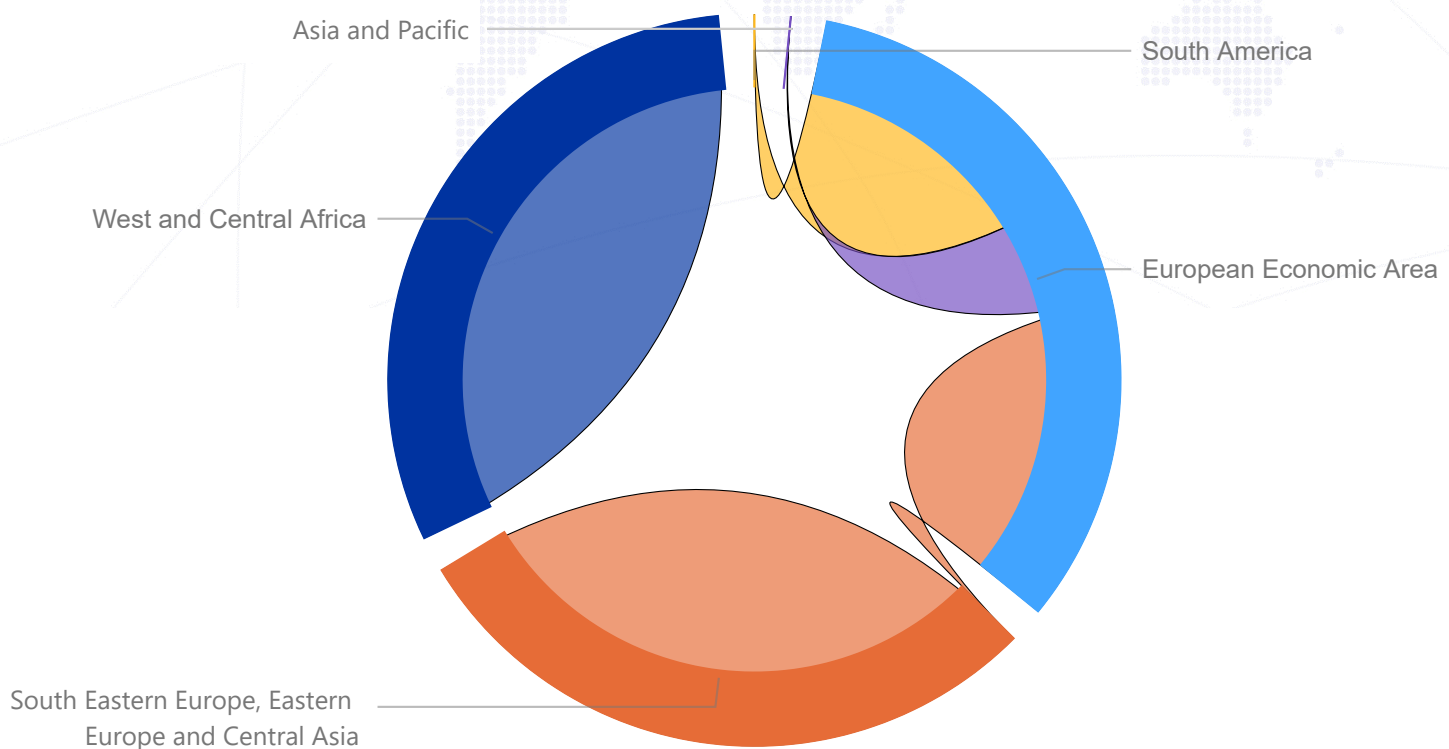
Top Host Countries
