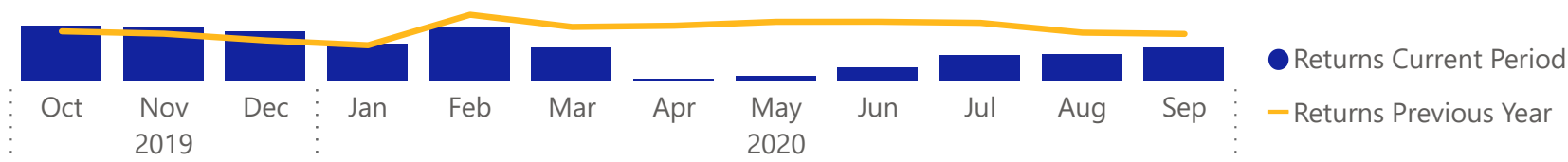

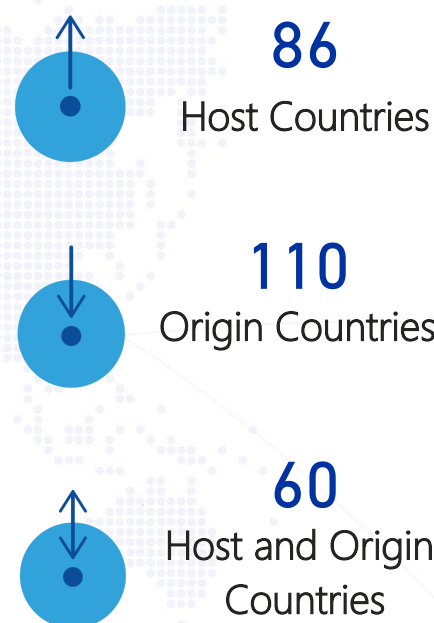

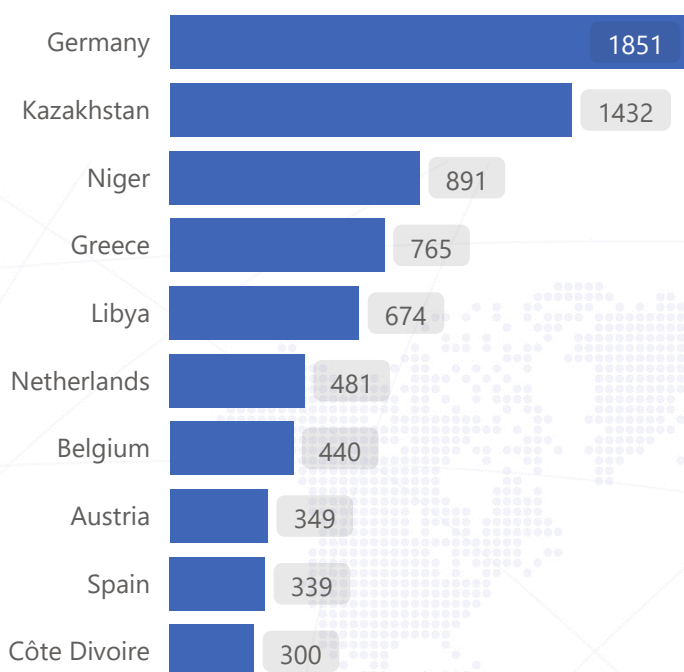

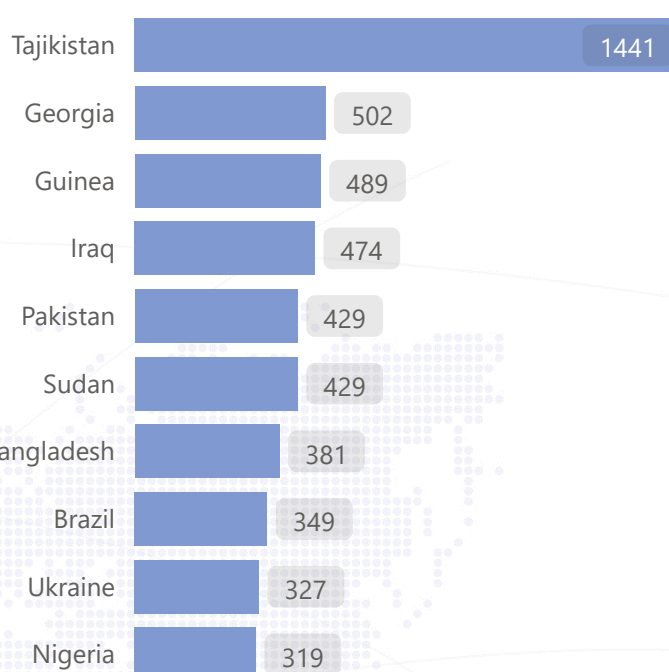

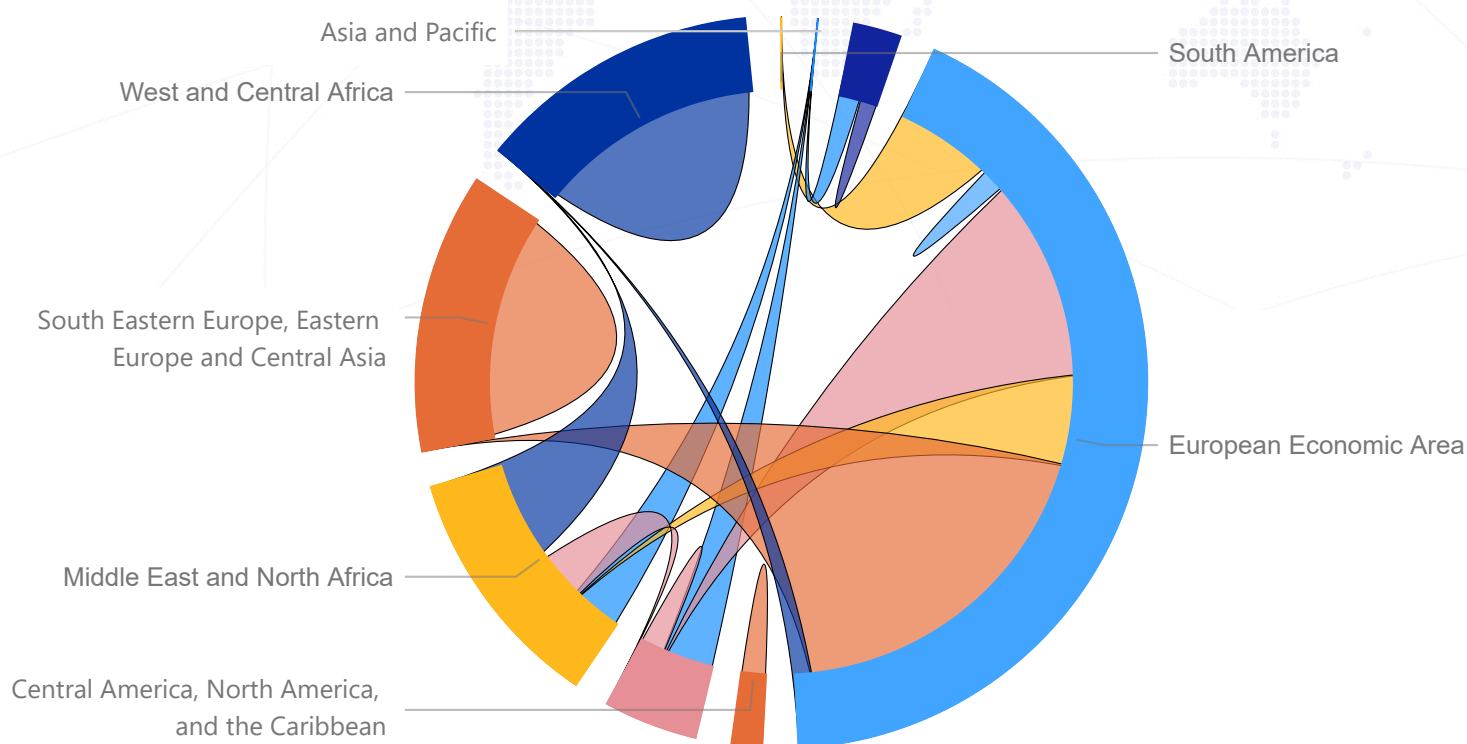
### Top Host Countries
