Is the capacity of individuals, communities, institutions, businesses, and systems within a city to survive, adapt, and grow no matter what kinds of **chronic stresses** and **acute shocks** they experience.

100RC provides cities **4 types of support** to address these problems

1. Funding to hire a **CHIEF RESILIENCE OFFICER (CRO)**



2. Support to develop a **CITY RESILIENCE STRATEGY**



3. A **PLATFORM OF SERVICES** to support strategy implementation



4. Membership in the **100RC NETWORK**

100RC selected its first group of 32 cities in December 2013, and announced 35 new cities in December 2014. Our 67 member cities span 40 countries and 24 languages. We will launch the Challenge to select the final 33 cities in late 2015.
