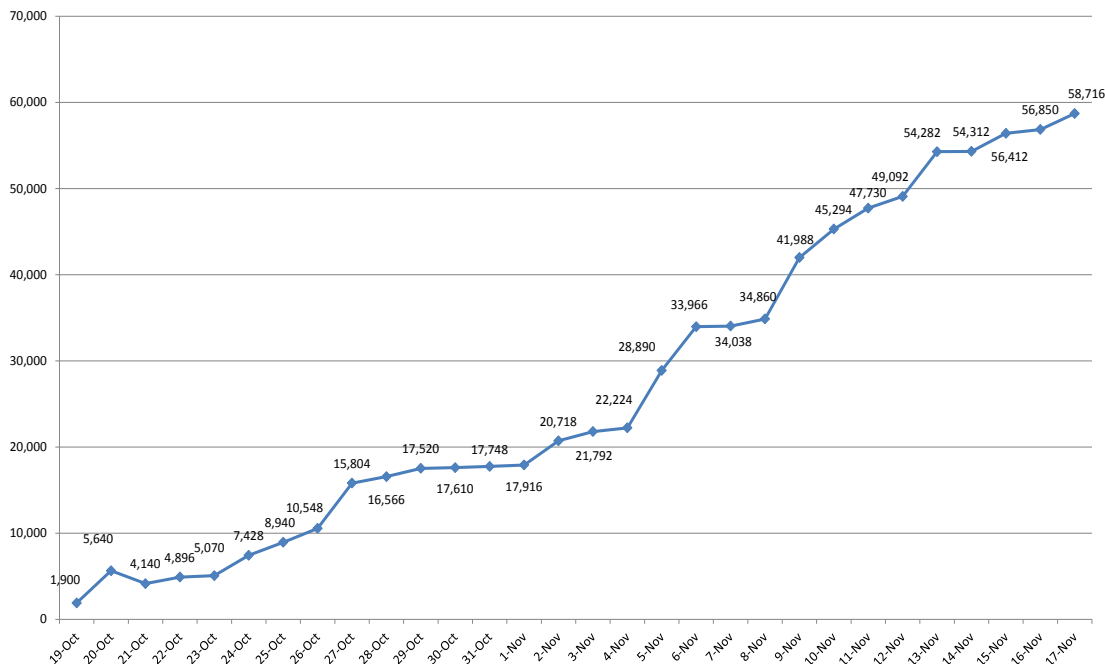


Total number of individuals currently displaced: 58,716*

Number of displaced individuals identified by Emergency Tracking since 17 October

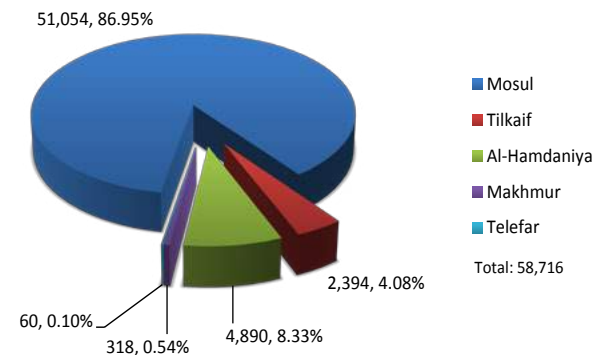


Notes from November 16:

- Approximately 4 new families from Baashiqa sub-district arrived to Zeilkan camp after passing through security screening in Nargazliya;
- The overall increase of 61 families in Zeilkan camp is due to further data validation;
- Approximately 250 families from Markaz Mosul sub-district reached Khazer M1 camp, after passing through security screening at the entrance of the camp.

*Emergency tracking numbers are **not** cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family.

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
