the ET update provides only a snapshot of the current displacement situation for the indicated date. The data and information reported on this page are related solely to the displacement caused by the Mosul operations which started on 17 October 2016.

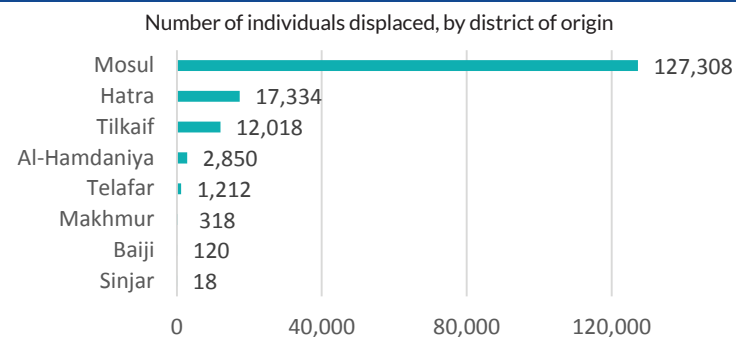

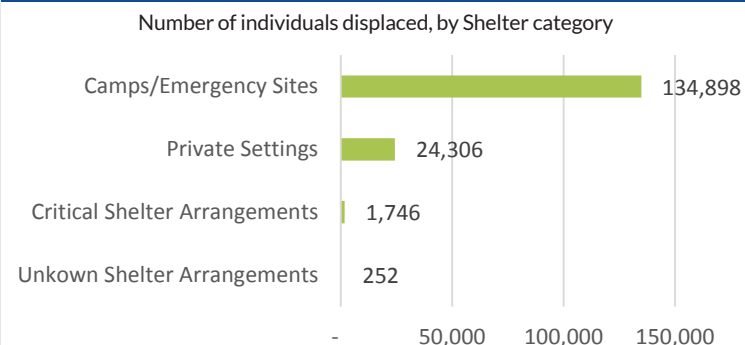

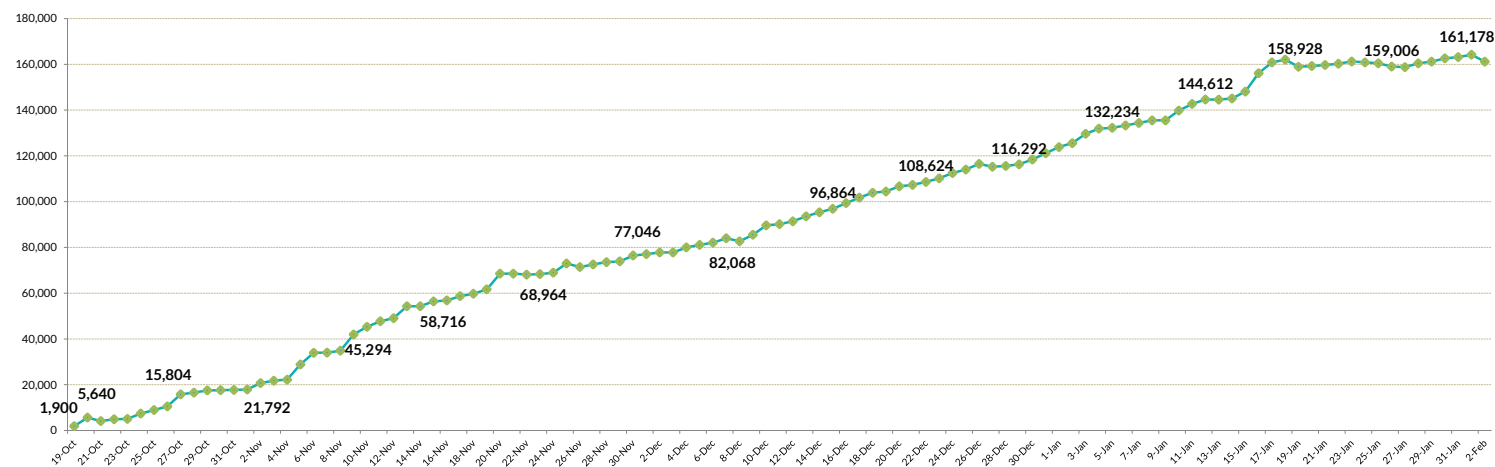

NUMBER OF DISPLACED INDIVIDUALS IDENTIFIED BY EMERGENCY TRACKING SINCE 17 OCTOBER



On 1 February:

- Field visit to Maghfera village allowed to assess the current number of IDP families still displaced to that location. A decrease has been reported. Reportedly, IDP families have moved to the camps in Hamdaniya district during the past weeks;
- 47 families arrived to Haj Ali camp and 8 families left;
- 47 families arrived to Qayyarah Airstrip emergency site and 1 family left. Figures have been adjusted following the new updates;
- 1 family arrived to Qayyarah Jad'ah 2 camp, and 2 families left;
- 8 families to Qayyarah Jad'ah 3 camp, and 7 families left;
- 339 families left Khazer M1 camp;
- 43 families arrived to camps in Merkaz Hamdaniya sub-district: a more precise breakdown will be provided in the coming updates.

*Emergency tracking numbers are not cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family.

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
