MOSUL OPERATIONS DATA SNAPSHOT: 26 JANUARY 2017

the ET update provides only a snapshot of the current displacement situation for the indicated date. The data and information reported on this page are related solely to the displacement caused by the Mosul operations which started on 17 October 2016.

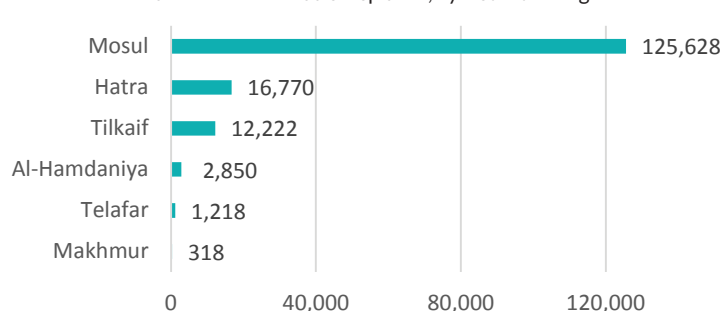

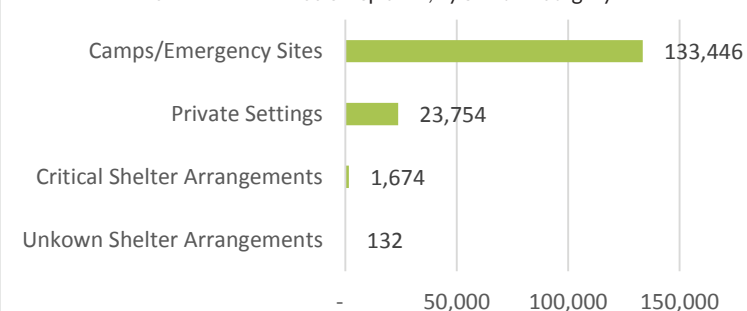

Number of individuals displaced, by district of origin

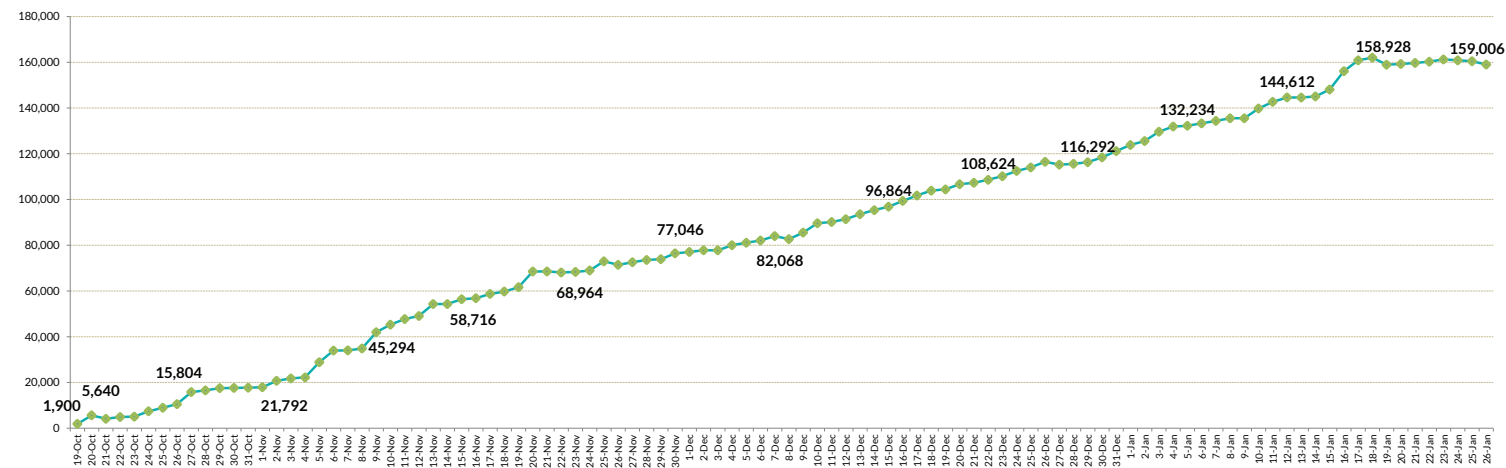


WHERE ARE PEOPLE STAYING?

NUMBER OF DISPLACED INDIVIDUALS IDENTIFIED BY EMERGENCY TRACKING SINCE 17 OCTOBER



On 25 January:

- Qayyarah Jad'ah camp received 7 families;
- Approximately 12 families reached Qayyarah Jad'ah 2 camp, while 3 families left;
- Approximately 10 families arrived to Qayyarah Jad'ah 3 camp, while 9 families left;
- Approximately 12 families left Qayyarah Airstrip emergency site;
- Approximately 36 families arrived to Haj Ali camp;
- Approximately 350 families left Khazer M1 camp;
- Nargizlia1 Camp received 41 families.

*Emergency tracking numbers are not cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family.

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
