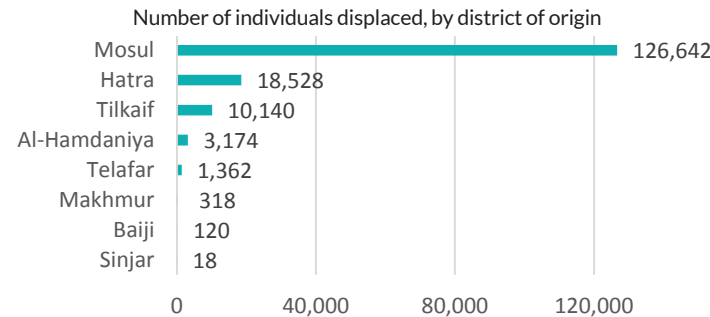

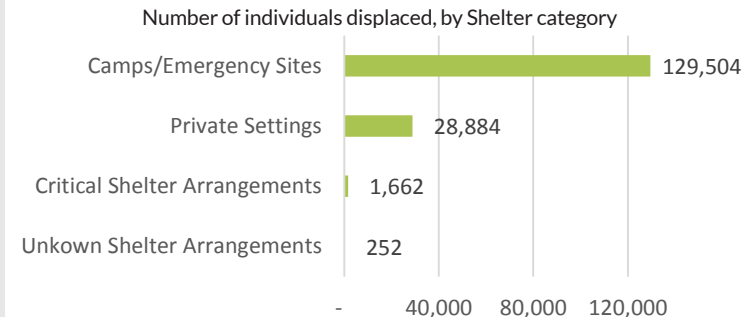

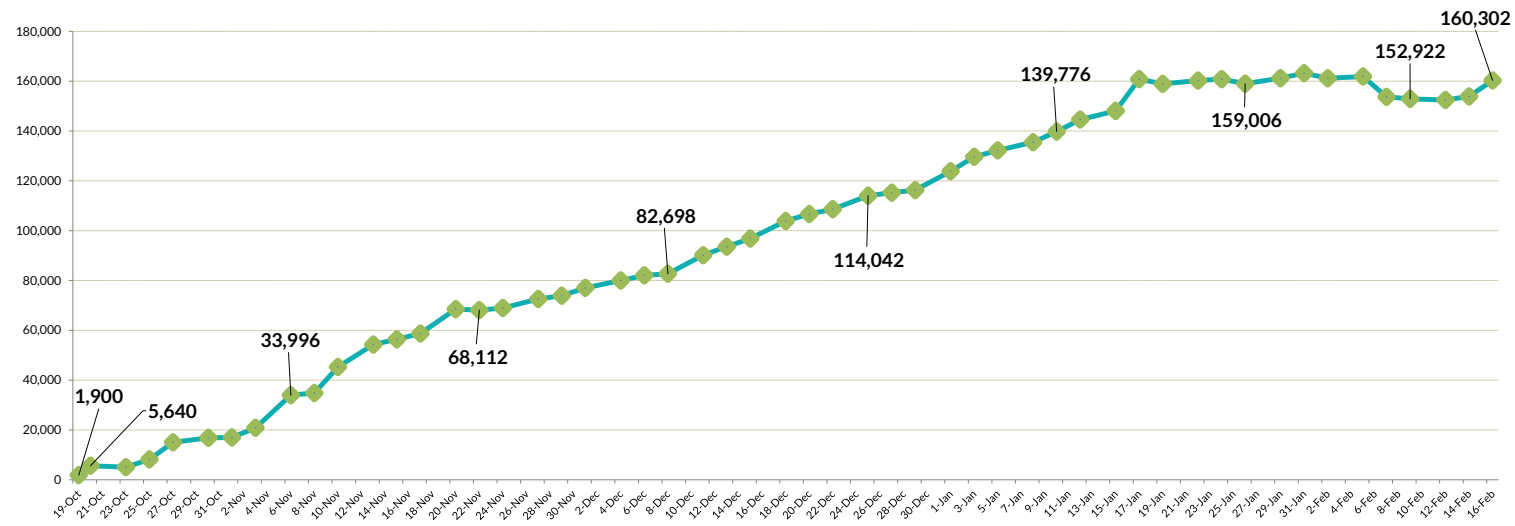

As of 15 February:

- Nargizlia 1 camp reported an increase of 37 IDP families from Merkaz Mosul and Merkaz Tilkaif sub-districts;
- Qaymawa (former Zelikan) camp reported a decrease of 170 IDP families, due to return movements;
- The DTM Mosul Portal reports an increase of approximately 446 IDP families in Qayyarah Airstrip emergency site. This is not due to new arrivals. The 446 families difference is represented by IDP families that are not fully registered and are still on the waiting list. This number is now added to the total number of registered IDP families. Hence, the current figures of Qayyarah Airstrip emergency site include registered and not fully registered families, while it used to include the number of registered families only;
- New IDP families are being identified in Salah al-Din and Baghdad governorates.

*Emergency tracking numbers are not cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family.

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
