## Overcoming Protracted Displacement in Iraq

*Supporting Durable Solutions to Displacement*

**Request for Expressions of Interest (REI) Stage– May 2020**

### Project Overview

In partnership with the Government of Iraq (GOI), IOM and an informal group of humanitarian, stabilisation and development actors (the “Iraq Durable Solutions Network”, or DSN) have created an operational strategy to facilitate safe and dignified access to sustainable returns for IDPs in situations of protracted displacement, while also seeking to promote initial steps in support of other durable solutions for people unable to return. These activities take place in the current context in which a large IDP population remains displaced in camps, many of which are scheduled to close by the end of 2020.

The required services that IOM is funding under this expression of Interest are: Protection Support, Protection Monitoring, Shelter Assistance, Livelihoods Assistance, Community Projects (Non-infrastructure), and Social Cohesion.

Organizations can apply to multiple services in multiple locations. ## Scope of expressions of interest

Bidders will be free to apply for one or several sectors, in one or several geographic locations. The Durable Solutions Network (DSN) has conducted a mapping of existing coverage for each sector and geographical area in order to identify existing gaps that require additional resources and presence to be able to support the targeted population groups. Based on the mapping, the DSN will support coordination amongst its members and with other organizations for a more effective response. This exercise will support potential partners that were selected at the expression of interest stage to prioritize their proposed interventions under the call for proposals stage.
