The International Organization for Migration (hereinafter called **IOM**) intends to engage qualified non-governmental organizations (NGOs) to submit expression of interest as Implementing Partners for the project *“Critical winterization and livelihoods support to the most vulnerable communities in Eastern Ukraine”*.
