A. Clarifications received during the Pre-Proposal Conference

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR ANALYTICAL STUDY ON MIGRATION, ENVIRONMENT, AND CLIMATE CHANGE IN THE EAST AND HORN OF AFRICA REGION

Num	Questions	Answers
1	Can the climate-conflict nexus be integrated into the assignment?	No, the assignment is centered around the 12 commitments and 5 requests articulated by signatory states to the Kampala Ministerial Declaration on Migration, Environment and Climate Change (MECC), as one of the outcomes of the assignment is the development of the Kampala Declaration Action Plan. Therefore the analytical study will undertake a stock-take of the 'state of affairs' related to the 12 commitments and also an analysis of the UNFCCC processes, mechanisms and political structures that can be leveraged to support the commitments and the 5 requests. As CC-conflict is not one of the 12 commitments, it is not expected to feature as a particular topic of the analytical study.
2	On the engagement with youth advocates, is there a group already formed that the consultancy firm can engage with or is it expected that they should reach through their own networks? Are there any other vulnerable groups the consultancy firm should reach out to?	There is a pre-formed group, who have been formed and supported by IOM, the UNFCCC's YOUNGO programme and Chatham House's 'Common Future Conversations' programme. This group contributed to the Kampala Declaration and are thus also expected to contribute to the Analytical Study and Action Plan. IOM's Country Offices can put the firm in touch with civil society, diaspora and migrant groups, but we do also expect the consultancy firm to cast a wider net and propose other contacts and/or groups to us.
3	Would the consultancy firm be expected to consult with all those groups in all 15 signatory countries or would a sample of countries suffice?	A sample of countries would be sufficient- this can be discussed and agreed with the Expert Working Group. One of their tasks is to contribute to the study.
4	How does the consultancy firm engage with the Expert Working Group? Physically or virtually?	There will be 2 opportunities for physical engagement with the EWG. The first when the group has their first meeting- the consultancy firm will be invited to attend in order to make contacts, connections and consult with the representatives. The second towards the end of the assignment when the EWG will again meet to review the first draft of the Action Plan and provide their inputs. Aside from that, e-mail, calls and video chats would be the main mode of communication.
5	What is the geographical location of the assignment?	As this is mostly a desk study with virtual consultations, aside from the 2 physical conferences, the geographical location is open.
6	Who are the interviewees- UN and others or can we also interview CSOs etc...	There is not particular requirement to interview UN organisations. As the assignment is pinned to the Kampala Declaration's 12 commitments and 5 requests, and as it was also developed with input from the migrant perspectives, from CSOs and youth, the same, wide group of interviewees would be expected, so the evidence presented by the study reflects the comprehensiveness of the Kampala Declaration, and the Action Plan is relevant to all stakeholders.
7	Who would the contract be with? IOM Kenya or Global IOM in Geneva?	IOM's Regional Office for the East and Horn of Africa based in Kenya.
