IOM's Humanitarian Work

IOM provided support in areas such as:

- ✓ Movement assistance
- ✓ Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

- ✓ Health
- ✓ Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH)



Mobility dimensions of crisis

IOM's work had an operational reach of over **31.7 million people** including internally displaced persons (IDPs), refugees and migrants



Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

3.2 million people living in **1,561 displacement sites** across **35 countries** reached through CCCM operations



Shelter and non-food item operations reached **4.8 million people** in **62 countries**



IOM Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM)

Information on **population mobility** has been collected, analyzed, and disseminated for **85 countries**

Movements have been tracked for over **78.4 million people**

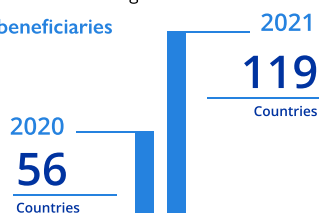


39.1 million Internally displaced persons (IDPs)	26.2 million IDP returnees	7.1 million returnees from abroad
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Cash-Based Interventions (CBIs)

CBIs modalities were used by IOM to implement activities in 119 countries reaching close to **1.9 million beneficiaries**



Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH)

13.3 million people reached through WASH operations in camps, camp-like settings and host communities in **62 countries**



Health Programming

Global health workforce of **2,600 people** were active in **40 countries** facing humanitarian situations



601 primary health-care facilities provided consultations in humanitarian/crisis contexts

11,683,366 direct beneficiaries



reached through health promotion, risk communication and community engagement activities

3,501,029 persons in crisis contexts directly reached with targeted COVID-19 related messages



Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS)

81 offices continued to provide MHPSS services to beneficiaries

1.6 million individuals reached through tailor-made MHPSS services

Type of MHPSS services

- ✓ Sociorelational and cultural services
- ✓ Non-formal education and learning services
- ✓ Sport and play services
- ✓ MHPSS services integrated in livelihood support services
- ✓ Counselling sessions
- ✓ MHPSS integrated in protection services for GBV victims
- ✓ Referral to specialized mental health services
- ✓ Art based services
- ✓ MHPSS services integrated in conflict mediation services
