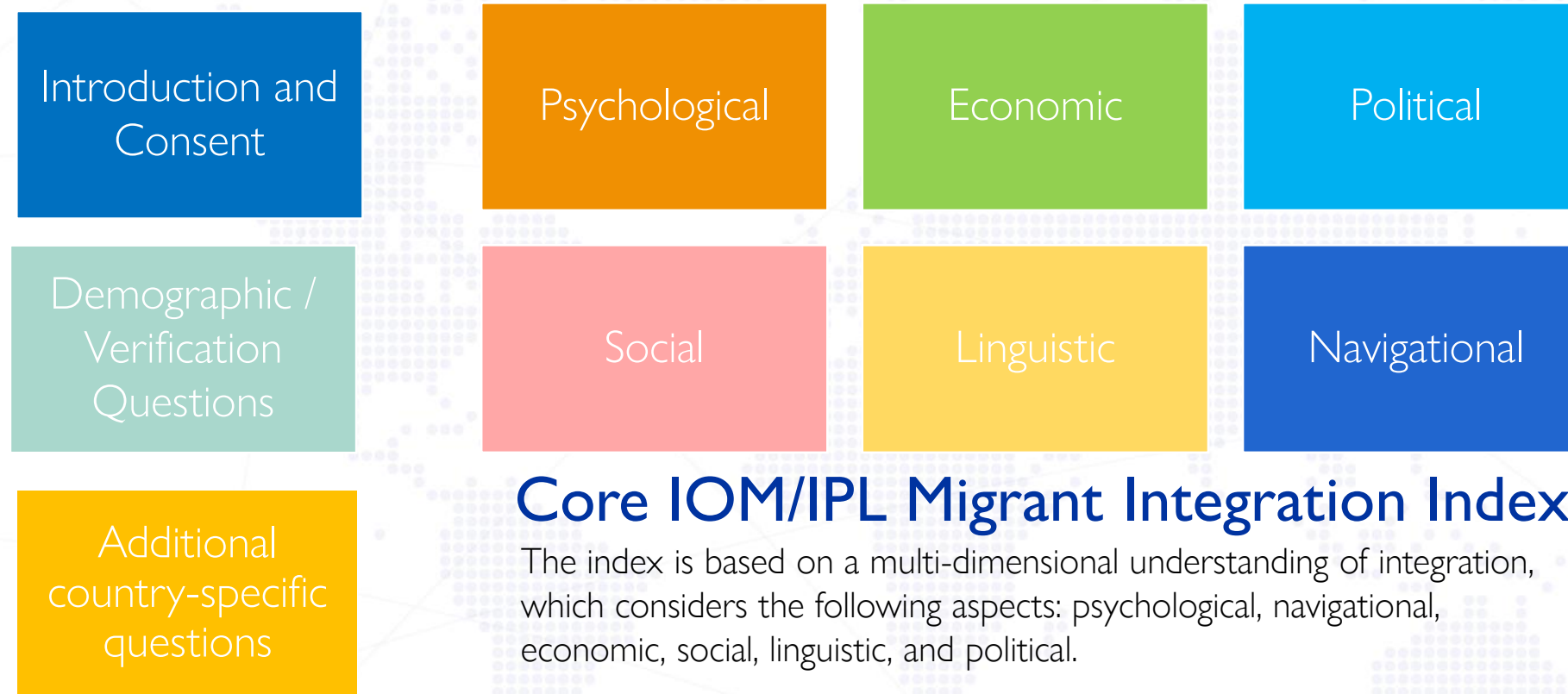


Structure of the IPL/IOM Migrant Integration Index



Core IOM/IPL Migrant Integration Index

The index is based on a multi-dimensional understanding of integration, which considers the following aspects: psychological, navigational, economic, social, linguistic, and political.

The index is available in short (IPL-12) and long (IPL-24) forms. Therefore, it is adaptable.
