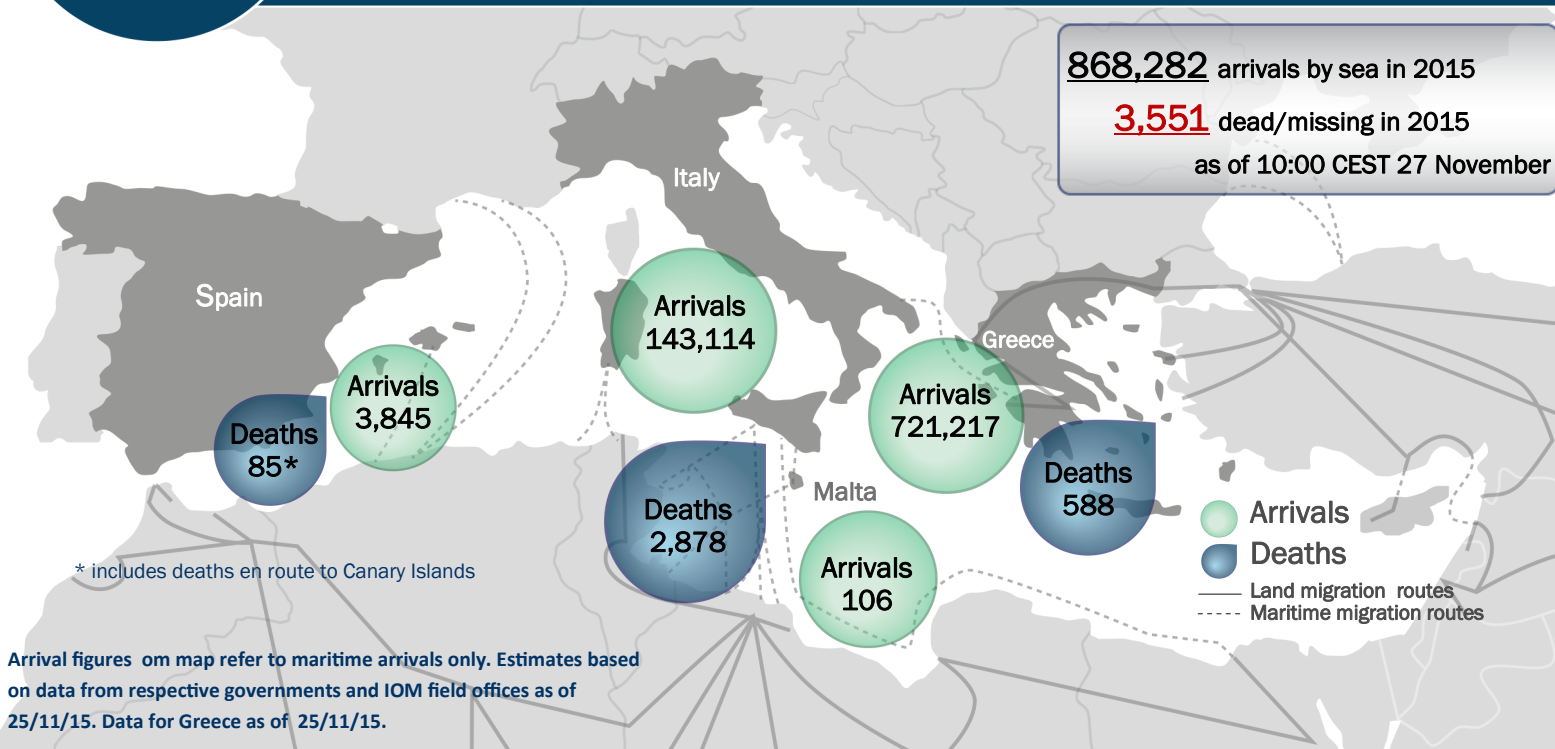




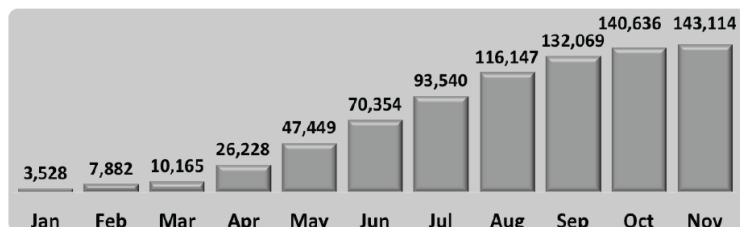

## Migration Flows Europe: Arrivals and Fatalities

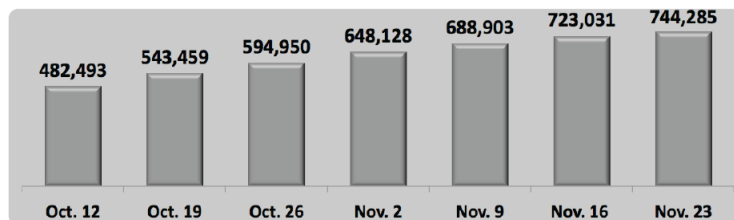

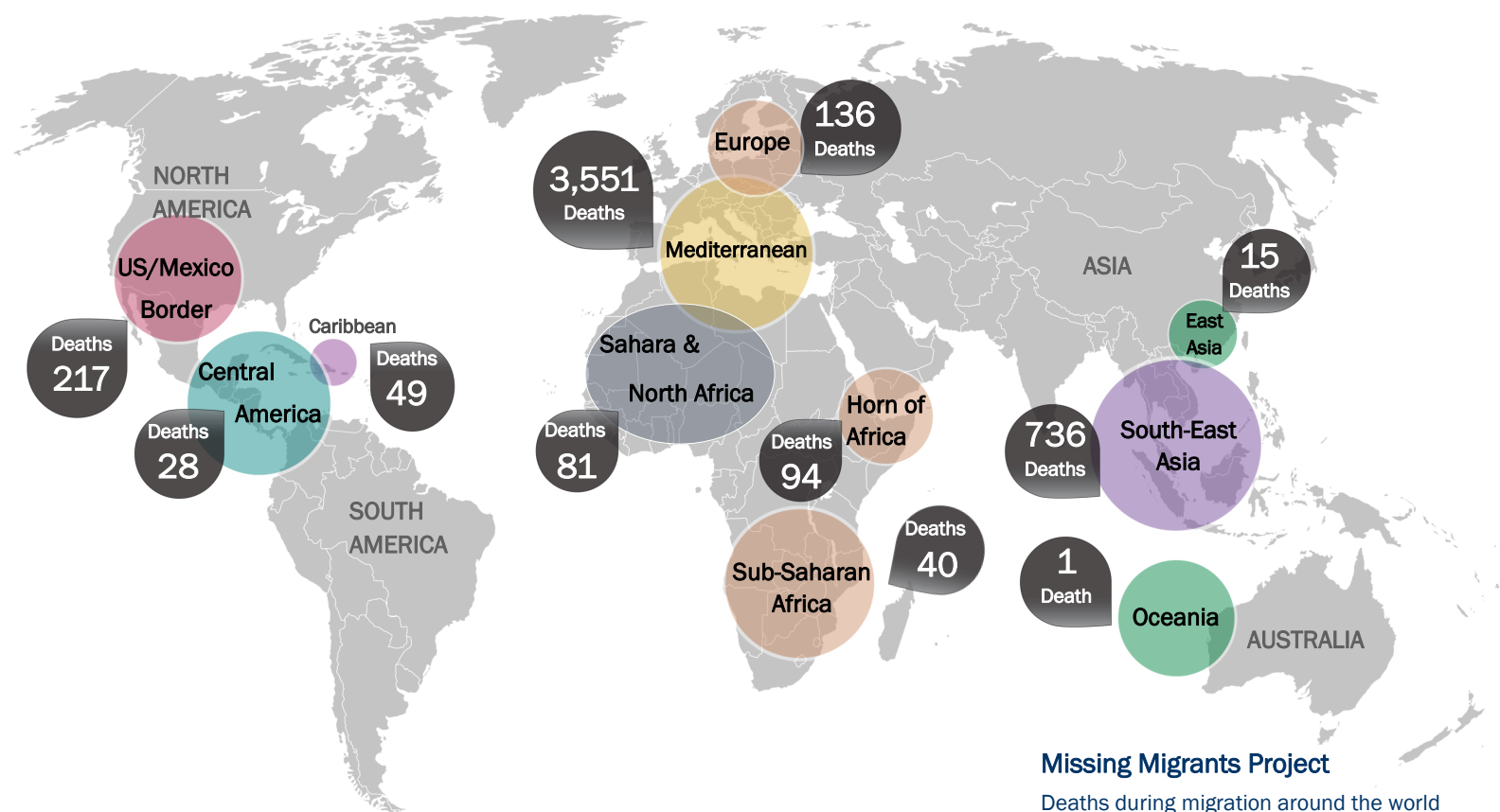

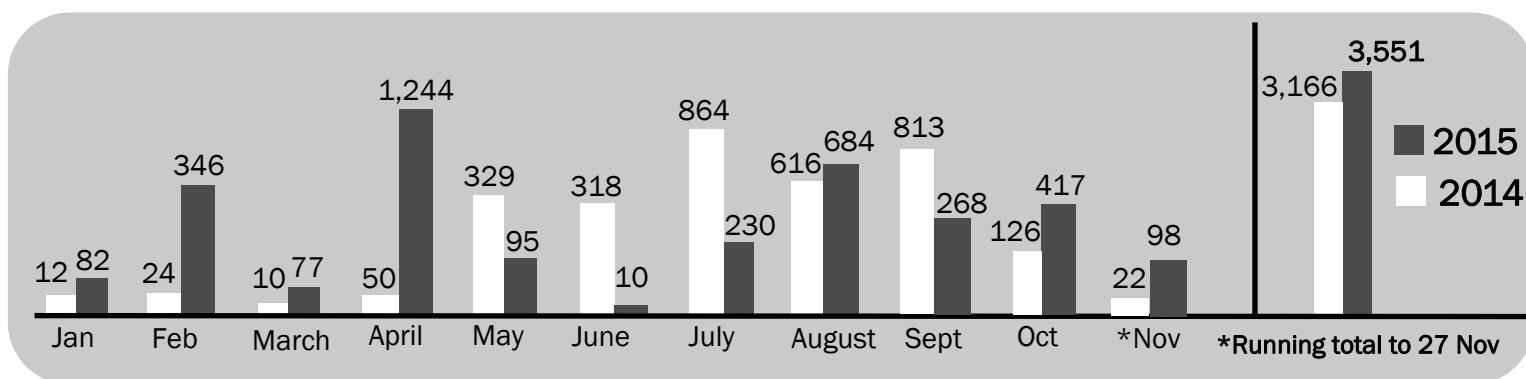
