For example, does this mean the proposal should include the evaluation at end of project, but not with mid-term project support (review and methods)?</i>	IOM has the overall responsibility for the monitoring and evaluation of all outcomes, including Outcome 3. The proposed services can include the evaluation they consider most appropriate for monitoring and evaluating this outcome, which may include either, or both, a mid-term evaluation and/or end project evaluation.
