Management Response and Actions IOM Country Office Yaoundé Audit File No. CM202001

The IOM Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducted an internal audit of the IOM Yaoundé (the “Country Office”) from 3 February to 7 February 2020. The audit assessed the risk exposure and risk management of the Country Office’s activities, in order to ensure these are well understood and controlled by the country-level management and staff. The audit covered the activities of the Country Office from January 2018 to December 2019. The results of the audit are public and can be accessed through IOM’s global website¹.

The OIG assessed the Office as ***largely ineffective***, and raised 20 audit findings and recommendations, of which 13 are very high and high priority. As of March 2022, all very high and high recommendations were closed and implemented and only one medium recommendation is in progress to be implemented.

OIG - Internal Audit Comment :

Internal Audit has positively noted the implementation of the majority of recommendations.
