APPLICATION BY THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA FOR REPRESENTATION BY AN OBSERVER

- 1. In a letter dated 27 November 2000, a copy of which is appended as Annex I, the Federal Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia made a formal application for his country to be accorded observer status at meetings of the IOM Council. The Director General's reply thereto, dated 27 November 2000, is appended as Annex II. An appropriate item will be included in the provisional agenda for the Council's Eightieth Session.
- 2. This matter falls under Rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure for the Council, which provides that the Council may admit, upon their application, non-member States as observers at its meetings.
- 3. If the Council so decides, the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia will be included among the non-member States listed in paragraph 1 of Resolution No. 753 (LVIII).
- 4. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council when this matter comes up for decision.
