1. In a letter dated 15 November 2010, the Kingdom of Swaziland applied for membership in the International Organization for Migration. A copy of the letter and of the Director General's reply, dated 17 November 2010, are annexed.
2. In accordance with Article 2 (b) of the Constitution, the Council is required to make a decision regarding the application of the Kingdom of Swaziland for membership and the rate of its contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, which the Director General recommends should be assessed at 0.0033 per cent of the total contributions required from Member States to the Administrative Part of the Budget.
3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council for consideration.

**LETTER DATED 15 NOVEMBER 2010 FROM THE
MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION
OF THE KINGDOM OF SWAZILAND TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF

Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the relationship existing between the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland and the International Organization for Migration (IOM).

My Government wishes to establish a closer relationship with your Organization and hereby applies for Membership in the International Organization for Migration in accordance with Article 2, paragraph (b) of the IOM Constitution.

The Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland accepts the Constitution, and the amendments thereto of 24 November 1998, in accordance with its constitutional processes and the obligations resulting from Membership. It also undertakes to make a financial contribution to the administration requirements of the Organization, the rate of which will be agreed upon by the IOM Council and the Government of the Kingdom.

I take pleasure in informing you that the Ninety-ninth Session of the Council, at which your Government's application will be submitted to the Member States of IOM for approval, will be held in Geneva, from 29 November to 2 December 2010.

A document formally presenting your Government's application for membership will be distributed to all Member States. You will receive a copy of it, together with further details concerning the Council session and the procedure for consideration of your country's application.
