MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO MIGRANTS

Through the support provided by the European Union, and in close collaboration with the Ministry of Health, IOM has provided health assistance to 3,651 migrants (75% male, 12% female and 12% children), with total of 4,620 different medical interventions during the period January 2017 - June 2019. The teams provided basic medical care and examinations for the migrants, as well as referral and coverage of the cost for hospital treatments for those in need. Largest number of migrants assisted suffered from dehydration and seasonal flue as well as flash injuries due to long walks. Special consideration is given to the protection of the health of the children.



PEER TO PEER EXPERIENCES FOR PREVENTION OF VIOLENT EXTREMISM (PVE)

The experts and practitioners from the educational sector and representatives from the staff of National PVE Coordinators Offices from North Macedonia and Albania attended roundtable meetings sharing their peer to peer experiences for prevention of violent extremism among youth. The meetings allowed the participants to exchange information, analyze and understand the local perspectives and actions that need to be undertaken.

The International Organization for Migration (IOM) reports that 26,090 migrants and refugees have entered Europe by sea through 19 June, roughly a 35 per cent decrease from the 40,846 arriving during the same period last year.

MIXED MIGRATION FLOWS IN THE MEDITERRANEAN AND IN THE WESTERN BALKANS

A total of 21,869 migrants and refugees arrived in Europe through different land and sea routes between January and April 2019, 29 per cent less than in the same period last year, when 30,961 sea and land arrivals were reported, 56 per cent less than the 50,108 arrivals registered in 2017 and 88 per cent less than the 189,370 registered between January and April 2016.
