Submission criteria and process

IOM welcomes submissions to the MRS throughout the year focusing on **any migration-related issues** that fall within IOM mandate and are policy-relevant (empirical research desirable).

Submitted papers should:

- ✓ be of **4,000 words** maximum. On the first page, please indicate the names and affiliations of the author(s)
- ✓ follow [MRS style guide](#) and the guidance note for authors
- ✓ be submitted by email to research@iom.int referring to 'MRS abstract submission' in the subject line

IOM endeavours to give a decision on publication within approximately two months after submission. All papers are first screened by IOM for suitability and then subject to double peer review.
