92% of migrants said they had some level of education, 8% said no education

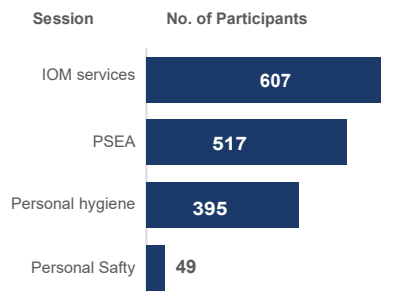


90% of the migrants said they had been in Yemen less than a month

Other Factors Contributing to a Migrant's Vulnerability Level

- 33 unaccompanied minors
- 38 migrants verbally abused
- 54 migrants psychologically abused
- 83 migrants deceived
- 77 migrants robbed
- 89 migrants threatened

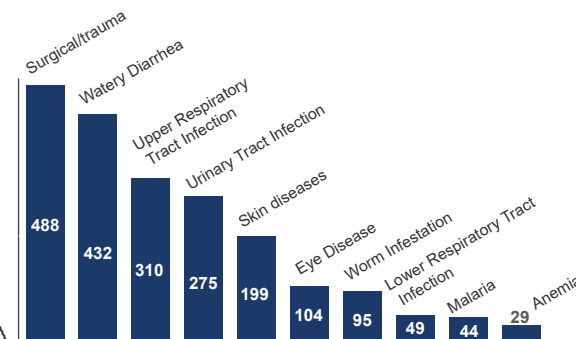

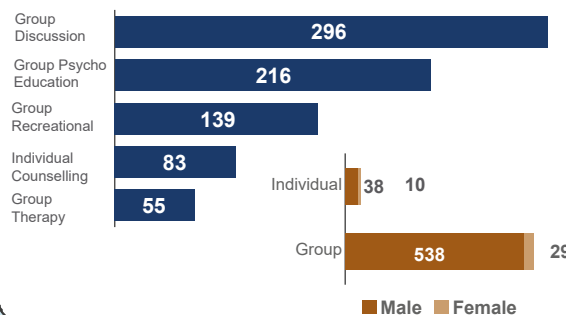

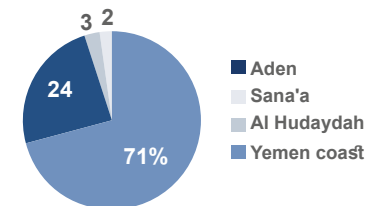
Health: Most Common Diagnosis
